He has been a graduate of the very first batch of Bhavan's Degree College, Sainikpuri, in the year 1996, Computer Science Batch. Having demonstrated a strong leaning to the creative side, he set out to pursue further studies at the Art Institute of Seattle and Majoring in New Media Design. Since then, he has been working over the past 25 years across various domains like Corporate Communication, Marketing, Business Development, Operations, Design and Animation.

You were one of the students in the very first batches of your stream at the college; how was that experience?

When we started in 1993, we were just 131 students—the whole college. We all took subjects like English in one big classroom. Most of the land around was empty, and the college was very prominent in the area, as there were no buildings outside of it either. We had a very strong bond with our teachers and friends, and it was new for all of us.

Apart from studies, how has the exposure at Bhavan's helped you in personal and professional growth?

I read 13 volumes of Swami Vivekanada in my first year. They had an extremely profound impact on my life, and it was an important step in my spiritual journey. My friendships, teachers, and the curriculum helped me understand where and how I fit in (and where I did not). I realised that I was interested in logic and reasoning but also had strong communication skills and a creative side. Professionally, I am not exactly in the same space that I started out, but it helped me to look at problems holistically, which is paramount as you grow in experience.

How much of the knowledge gained during your college education do you find applicable in real-world situations?

I would say that problem solving and a lot of experiences with decisions that were taken previously helped me tackle real-world situations. It is not the knowledge per se, but the experience of failing and succeeding after certain decisions that gives you insight as to how to go about it the next time around. The situations and time change, but the nature of the problems is very often the same.

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If you were to give advice to 18-year-old Dinesh Keerthy, what would it be?

Don't study at the last minute. Train your focus and ability to grasp. Explore more and do more. As you grow, the resources in your hands, like time, health, attention, and energy, slowly dissipate. Make the best use of them. What you sow at that time, you reap in the future, and it stays forever with you. Hard work never goes to waste.

What are some key lessons you've learned throughout your 25-year professional journey?

- It's all about the people. Be it customers or employees
- There is only one kind of sustainable leadership: the one where you are a coach, a mentor, and a visionary. Everything else falls away sooner or later.
- Search fervently for what you love, and then make it your calling.
- Don't be afraid to fail; it is the path to real success.
- Fail fast, and pick yourself up faster. Get better at this because it is the only skill you need in life.
- Be bold and take risks. Do not be afraid to accept change. Being truly secure means relying on the strength that comes from within.
- Do not worry about the past or the future. Always stay in the present. Soon, it will be gone.

How do you weave reading into your day-to-day life, and which books or authors have greatly influenced your approach to work and life?

Most of my early life has been between the pages of a book. I have too many of them ready. J. Krishmaurthy, Swami Vivekananda, and PJ Saher have been early influences in my life. There are lots of inspiring leaders and speakers like Anthony Robbins and Simon Sinek, and lots of fiction and self-help books. Daniel Goldman, Carl Jung, and many, many more. I can't seem to recall so many more.

What prompted your transition from computer science to further studies in new media design?

I knew I was a creative guy at heart, although I loved coding, logic, and reasoning. I will still use all my skills, but just on this side of the fence. There is no right answer to it. I sometimes feel I could stay on that side. But you make all decisions based on where you are at that moment and what your heart tells you. We have to move in that direction and make peace with all the alternatives for the future.

What inspired your startups, like PhotoGurus, etc., and what challenges did you encounter during their inception and growth?

All such startup ideas are ignited because of a deep need for a product. Honing in on the right kind of need is what sets your product apart and helps it stand out. PhotoGurus started out as an idea to create self-curated photo memories. All of us take photos, and almost unlimited photos, because everything is digital today. But do you do anything besides posting something on Instagram? Many don't even do that. The photos taken on so many vacations just lie and get backed up. That's where self-curated photo memories like books and slideshows come in.

ALL INDIA THAL SAINIK CAMP



The All India Thal Sainik Camp is a centrally organised camp by the DG NCC at the DG NCC Camp Area, New Delhi, every year specifically for the army wing cadets, which includes various events viz. Obstacle Training, Map Reading, Health & Hygiene, Judging Distance & Field Signals (JDFS), Tent Pitching and Firing. More than 2000 cadets from 17 Directorates take part in the 15-day-long camp at New Delhi. The selections for this camp started in the month of May, where the cadets from various colleges got shortlisted for the Inter Unit Competition (IUC) at 1 EME CENTRE, Bolaram. The cadets were then selected for the Inter Group Competition (IGC), which was held at Tirupati in August, where around 300 cadets competed in various events. The cadets who were shortlisted for the training camps were then called for further selection at Anantapur, Kurnool for SDs, Tirupati for SWs, and Kakinada for the firing team. A total of 99 cadets were selected for AITSC 2023 in Delhi, among which 8 cadets from 12/2 COY, Bhavans Vivekananda College. SUO E Sai Sandeep Reddy, being the Contingent Commander of AP & T DTE, was given the responsibility of taking care of the regular fall-ins of the cadets. We arrived in Delhi on September 19, 2023, and were taken to the DG NCC camp area at Cariappa Parade Grounds. We had 6 different events along with the firing.

AITSC 2023 began with an opening address by DG NCC Lt. GEN GURBIRPAL SINGH AVSM, VSM, at the Auditorium. The next day onwards, the competitions started, where the first was Judging Distance & Field Signals, followed by Health & Hygiene, Map Reading, Obstacle Training, Firing on subsequent days, and in the end. Tent Pitching was organised. Along with these primary competitions, we also had subsidiary competitions like line area (which was one of the most stressful and enjoyable tasks to do from as soon as we wake up until we sleep and even at midnight). Tug of war, Public Speaking and Quiz competitions. The events were finished by September 27, 2023, and we were waiting for our results to be announced the next day.
