
# General Quiz (30th & 31st July 2018)

The Bhavan's Quiz Club organised its Business Quiz competition called "Udhyam" on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2018. The event was held from 2.30 pm onwards in room no. 71 of the Biochemistry Block. Udhyam is an open-to-all business quiz i.e., it is open to UG and PG students of all years and all streams. Udhyam is a team event and each team had to consist of 2 students. In total, Udhyam has seen a participation of 50 teams from all over the college.

Udhyam was divided into 4 rounds. The first round was a pen and paper, Preliminary Round and the top 13 teams were shortlisted based on merit. These 13 teams went head to head in the further rounds.

The second round was a Print Ads Round where the participants were shown print ads of different companies/brands and the teams had to identify the company/brand the print ad belongs to. After this round, top 7 teams were shortlisted based on their scores.

The third and final round was a Driver and Passenger Round where the participants from the same team were separated, one of them would be the driver while the other would be the passenger. They would answer the same questions separately; depending on their coordination and individual knowledge, points would be awarded to the team.

With that final round, Udhyam - the Business Quiz came to an end where the top 3 teams stood as the Quiz wizards. S. Darshan Jain and P. Varshit from B.Com 2B were the winners while Sai Chander T. and Vivek Reddy from B.Sc. MPCS (3rd year) placed second; and Mohsin Shaik and Sai Kalyan from B.Com 2D and 2C respectively, placed third.
