Here, the participants were shown pictures or videos and had to answer the questions based on them. This multimedia challenge tested their knowledge across various formats, including images, audio clips, and video snippets.

## **MANTHAN - 2024**

The Quiz Club of Bhavan's Vivekananda College of Sciences, Humanities, and Commerce conducted MANTHAN - A National level Business Quiz, on February 12, 2024. The competition attracted participants from renowned educational institutions, showcasing their expertise and acumen in business-related domains.

The quiz followed a rigorous format comprising multiple rounds, each meticulously crafted to challenge participants' understanding of diverse business concepts. The rounds encompassed a blend of traditional quiz elements, including riddles, decoding, pounce and audio-visual rounds ensuring an engaging and intellectually stimulating experience for all.

In the first round, participants were asked questions in form of riddles and coded questions. This round was "Pounce", this round unfolded seamlessly, fostering an environment of active participation and quick thinking among participants. Raising their hands after each question, the contestants displayed enthusiasm and readiness. Volunteers efficiently identified the first respondent, and the absence of pass questions encouraged participants to tackle each query. No eliminations took place in the first round.

Following the initial round was the second round in which every team was individually asked two questions, after which only 12 teams of the 24 qualified for the next round. The third segment unfolded as the “Multimedia Round”. In this round, participants encountered questions accompanied by images, videos and audios, requiring them to derive answers from the multimedia content. This unique challenge assessed their expertise across diverse formats, encompassing images, audio clips, and video snippets. Then a tie-breaker round was also conducted between 4 teams, in which the teams had a pounce round of 5 business questions. Finally, one team of this four was selected and then the top 6 teams qualified for the next and the final round.

The final round was the stress interview round in which 4 interviewers and 4 panelists were seated, where each team was called in individually and the same set of business questions were asked but adding to it stress environment was created. This helped us to assess the teams based on their stress management abilities. After this round, we got the top 3 teams of MANTHAN – 2024.

The Valedictory session then took place, where the Student Coordinators of Quiz club for 2023-2024 were felicitated and prizes and certificates were distributed to the winners by Dr. GSVRK Choudhary, Principal, Bhavan's Vivekananda College and Mrs. Sreedevi, faculty coordinator of Quiz club.
