The Quiz Club of Bhavan's Vivekananda College hosted a crime-themed event, CasoCerrado, which attracted 37 teams of two members each. The event was judged by SnehaSimhadri, Mansi Parichha, Shaik Rasheed, and KanchanKandadai.

The first round, Clue Grid, required participants to fill in a crossword grid with correct answers to accompanying questions. Seventeen teams were eliminated in this round, leaving 20 teams to advance to the next round, Crime Files Fact Check.

In Crime Files Fact Check, teams were presented with statements and tasked with identifying whether they were myths or facts. Ten teams qualified for the final round, Cipher Sleuth, which consisted of two sub-rounds.

The first sub-round involved completing a Google Form with nine riddles. After answering correctly, teams had to deduce the passcode for the next sub-round by combining the first letter of each answer. In the second sub-round, teams used the passcode to access a locked PDF containing two case studies of international serial killers. Each case study included questions, and teams recorded their answers on a provided sheet.

The winners of the event were JonshuaParnandi and Vedant Mohan Khadangale, while Shaik Mustafa KhajaAlman and Rohit Kumar Sankhua secured the runner-up position.

Teams had to identify the companies based on the information provided and answer the accompanying questions. Following this round, eight teams advanced to the final round, The Quiz Master's Challenge, led by Prof. Narendranath Menon as the quiz master.

Led by Prof. Narendranath Menon, the final round was both engaging and challenging, covering a wide range of business topics. The atmosphere in the room was filled with excitement as each team gave their best, answering with confidence and presence of mind. After a closely fought round, the team from Bhavan's Vivekananda College — V. Krishna Kalyan and Rajeev Nehal — emerged as the winners. The runner-up position was secured by Sarthak Gulyani and Karthikeyan Moopanar from NIPER, who also delivered a strong performance.
