INVENTIONS & DISCOVERIES

When was Surgery first used?

Surgery has been carried out since very ancient times. Ancient people all over the world used flints as surgical instruments. One of the most difficult and dangerous operations of all, opening the skull, was performed in ancient times with flints! And this goes back to prehistoric times. Flints were also used to open abscesses and to let out blood. Other instru-

were the teeth of fish and even sharp thorns. Cataracts were removed from the eye with thorns. As the knowledge about tools improved, saws for use in amputation were made from flints and from bones. These things are known to be true because many mummies show the results of such operations. Complicated instruments including scissors, iron needles etc. came into use when people

learned the art of making tools out of wood and iron. With the improvement in instruments, more difficult operations were performed. There are records that most of the operations done today, major ones, in ancient times, in some very complicated operations, formed for the removal of
