Mr.M.Thirimal Rao , Coordinator Ed cell briefing about the activities and support provided by the cell.

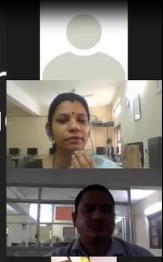
Dr.Kavitha Lal provided clear insights on the activities of done by IPR Cell and gave a brief introduction on different Intellectual Property Rights.
