Year 2014-15 has been a very eventful and satisfying. After securing 'A' Grade from NAAC during 2012-13, the College is on its way to seek Autonomous status from Osmania University/UGC. I deem it as my privilege to present the annual report for the academic year 2014-15.

Results:

We take pride in mentioning that consistency in results has become a tradition of the college. The results of 2013-14 have been very encouraging. The average pass percentage of UG courses is 90.24 with BBA and BCA leading with 100 % followed by B.A with 95.83%, B.com with 95.25%, B.Sc(Life Sciences)with 80.33% and B.Sc(Physical Sciences) with 79.92%. The average pass percentage for postgraduate courses is 97.59 with MBA and M.Sc(Biochemistry) leading with 100% followed M.Sc(Microbiology) with 88.89 % and M.Sc(Comp. Sc) with 86.67%.
