During the last twenty three years we were able to make a mark for Bhavan's Vivekananda College as an institution for quality education. From an institution which offers few UG Courses, we made rapid strides to offer multi-faculty courses in UG, PG and Doctoral programme. At present we have 12 UG courses, 5 PG courses and Ph.D in Microbiology. We are in the process of establishing complete autonomy. I take this as an opportunity to showcase the achievements of the college with the Annual report 2016-17.

Results:

We take pride in mentioning that consistency in result has become the hallmark of the college. The results of 2015-16 have been very encouraging. The average pass percentage of UG courses is 92.62% with BBA and BCA leading with 100% followed by B.Com with 98.54%, B.Sc(Life Sciences) with 90.83%, B.A with 89.47% and B.Sc(Physical Sciences) with 81.51%. The average pass percentage for postgraduate courses is 94.63% where MBA leads with 99.09% followed by M.Com with 96.30%, M.Sc(Microbiology) with 88.89%, M.Sc(Biochemistry) with 85.71% and M.Sc(Comp. Sc) with 85% .
