I extend a very hearty welcome to the 24th Annual Day celebrations of Bhavan's Vivekananda College. This academic year is very special, as it is the Silver Jubilee year of the college. During the last twenty-four years Bhavan's Vivekananda College has been able to make a mark as an institution synonymous with quality education. The institution made a humble beginning with a few UG Courses, but over a period of time it made rapid strides and started many courses in the faculties of Sciences, Commerce, Management, Humanities and Informatics. At present the college offers 12 UG courses, 5 PG courses and Ph.D in Microbiology. I take this opportunity to showcase the achievements of the college in the Annual report 2017-18.

Results:

Our students have been performing exceedingly well in academics both under University system and also Autonomous system. During the last 24 years, our students have secured more than 80 Osmania University top ten ranks for various courses. The average pass percentage of UG courses is 88.27% with BBA leading with 96.25% followed by BCA with 94%, B.Com with 93.82%, B.A with 86.96%, B.Sc(Life Sciences) with 83.78% and B.Sc(Physical Sciences) with 77.61%. The average pass percentage for postgraduate courses is 97.44% where M.Com and M.Sc(Computer Sc.) lead with 100% followed by M.B.A with 97.32%, M.Sc(Microbiology) with 95.83% and M.Sc(Biochemistry) with 95.65%.
