The year 2015–16 has been very eventful and satisfying. After securing 'A' Grade from NAAC during 2012–13 the college was granted Autonomous status by Osmania University/UGC in May 2015. We commenced the academic year 2015–16 as an autonomous college of Osmania University. I deem it as my privilege to present the annual report for the academic year 2015–2016.

Results:

We take pride in mentioning that consistency in good result has become the tradition of the college. The results of 2014–15 have been very encouraging. The average pass percentage of UG courses is 91.86% with BA and BCA leading with 100% followed by B.B.A with 96.92%, B.Sc(Life Sciences) with 96.43%, B.Com with 96.28% and B.Sc(Physical Sciences) with 78.10%. The average pass percentage for postgraduate courses is 94.55% with MBA and M.Sc(Biochemistry) leading with 100% followed by M.Sc(Comp. Sc) with 79.31% and M.Sc(Microbiology) with 72.73%.
