The college was established in the year 1993, under the aegis of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Mumbai. The college was accredited with grade A by NAAC in 2012 and became an Autonomous institution in the year 2015. The college offers 12 UG programmes, 5 PG programmes and a Ph.D programme in Microbiology. In the last twenty-five years the college has made great strides in the field of education and research and has emerged as one of the top 200 colleges in the country by NIRF ranking. I take this opportunity to showcase the achievements of the college in the Annual report 2018-19.

Results:

The bar of academic performance is being raised year after year, This year our students have performed exceedingly well in comparison to previous years. The average pass percentage of UG courses is 93.61% in comparison to the previous year 88.70%. BBA is leading with 98.44% followed by B.Com. with 97.72%, BCA with 92.45%, B.A with 92.31%, B.Sc.(Physical Sciences) with 89.79% and B.Sc.(Life Sciences) with 86.01%.

The average pass percentage for postgraduate courses is 99.1% in comparison to previous year 97.76%. M.Com, M.Sc.(Computer Sc. & Microbiology) have achieved 100% result. M.B.A achieved 99.12%, and M.Sc.(Biochemistry) with 95.23%.
