On behalf of the staff and students, I extend a warm welcome to one and all to the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Day celebrations at Bhavan's Vivekananda College. We are very honoured to have a luminary - Shri. Navin Mittal as our chief guest for this special day.

The college was established in the year 1993, under the aegis of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Mumbai . The college was accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC in 2012 and became an Autonomous institution in the year 2015. The college offers 12 UG programmes, 5 PG programmes and two Ph.D programmes in Microbiology& Biochemistry. In the last twenty six years the college has made great strides in the field of education and research and has emerged as one of the top 200 colleges in the country according to NIRF ranking. I deem it as my privilege to showcase the achievements of the college and present the Annual report for 2019-20.

#### **Results:**

Every year our students are consistently raising the bar of academic performance This year our students have performed exceedingly well in comparison to previous years. The average pass percentage of UG courses is 94.25% in comparison to the previous year result of 93.61%. BA, BCA & B.Com. (Computers) have achieved 100% result, followed by BBA with 98.39%, B.Com.(Reg. & Hons.) with 96.96%, B.Sc. (Physical Sciences) with 90.9% and B.Sc. (Life Sciences) with 86.95%.

The average pass percentage for postgraduate courses is 99.13% in comparison to last year's result of 99.1% .M.Sc. (Microbiology, Biochemistry & Computer Science) along with MBA have achieved 100% result, followed by M.Com. with 89.47%.

 65.92% of undergraduate students passed with CGPA of 7 and above and 84.78% of postgraduate students passed with CGPA of 7 and above.

#### STAFF ACHIEVEMENTS/RECOGNITIONS:-

#### DBT Star College Scheme:

As reported last year the college was awarded Star College Status by Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India. The college was sanctioned Rs.1.23 cores as financial support to implement the scheme for a duration of three years i.e 2019-2022. Six Science Departments of the college - Biochemistry, Microbiology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Physics & Electronics and Mathematics & Statistics received an amount of Rs. 81 lakhs for the current year. Non recurring grant of Rs 60 lakhs worth was utilised towards purchase of instruments for the conduct of experiments and Rs.21 lakhs towards conduct of star college activities.

#### Student centric Activities :

This scheme has given opportunity to undergraduate science students to interact with subject experts, visit research institutes and industries, attend skill based training programs, participate in workshops and perform interdisciplinary research projects in the current year. The following programmes were organised successfully.

- 13 guest lectures
- 9 field visits
- 8 workshop training programs for students
- 12 inter-disciplinary projects involving 50 students
- ✤ 10 departmental projects involving 70 students

#### Teacher centric Activities:

This scheme also enriched science faculty in updating their knowledge and skill in various upcoming areas. Our faculty went as resource persons and conducted training and outreach programmes for government school and college level teachers.

25 workshops / training programs were attended by faculty at different places

 9 outreach programs for school and college teachers These programmes received lot of appreciation. There was an overwhelming response by teachers from all over the state and around 210 teachers were trained for science experiments.
