#### Vision

The vision of BVC is "Youth empowerment with Culture, Knowledge and Strength of Body and Mind".

The College aims to fulfill this vision by orienting its academic and allied activities to bring all round development of a student by maximizing his/her intelligence/emotional/social/physical/spiritual quotient; and help in personality development, character building and career formation.

On the knowledge front, the college offers undergraduate programmes in Faculties of Science, Commerce, Humanities, Management and Informatics and postgraduate programmes in the Faculties of Science, Commerce and Management; and includes courses that have relevance to local, national and international needs. The student has a wide choice of subjects, and teaching is a blend of the conventional 'chalk and duster' method and technology driven online method. The courses include core, applied, elective, skill enhancement, generic topics, in addition to those of social, gender and environmental concerns. The expected outcome is a T-shaped individual with depth in domain knowledge and breadth in inter-disciplinary areas. Student support facilities are many, and mentoring continues throughout their stay in the college. The College has bagged 28 university ranks/gold medals in 21 years.

On the cultural front, students are exposed to the concepts of moral and value-based education. For this purpose, lectures by eminent persons/gurus are arranged in association with Ramakrishna Math, intensely in the first two weeks of a student's entry and occasionally throughout their college life.

The basics of culture, Indian heritage, human values, social responsibility and the importance of value-based education are imparted to the students and faculty. These values are propagated through the activities of NCC, NSS, Scouts & Guides, Young India, and Youth Red Cross units in the college. Strength of body and mind among the students is achieved by training in Sports and Games, both indoor and outdoor. The College has an enviable record on this front - 14 times inter-collegiate champions since 2003, and has won medals in 42 National and 5 International events in the last 5 years.

The college has thus succeeded in upholding its vision.




