

Dr.N.S.Chakravarty , Head Department of Management studies oriented the students about the department followed by the introduction of the faculty .


Dr.MVS. Mahendra, Associate Professor, Department of Management Studies gave a clear picture about subjects and examination pattern.

Dr.V.Venu Madhav Associate Professor, Department of Management studies explained the rules and regulations to be followed in the college.

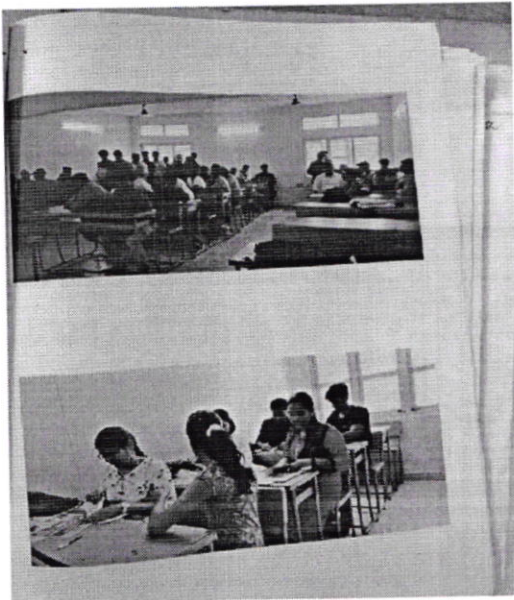
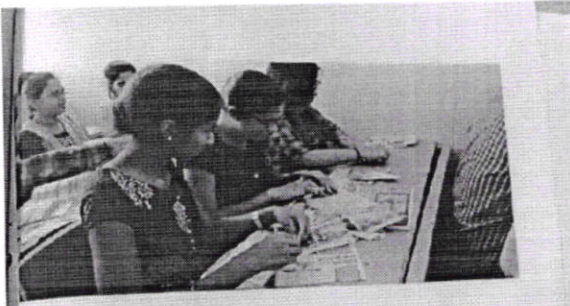
Dr. Kavitha Lal, Coordinator BBA gave a clear picture on the classes being held for the semester and divided them into two sections and introduced the respective class teachers.
