Panel Discussion on Union Budget 2019-20




Bhavan's College panel discusses Union Budget




















Elocution






Health Camp-2019


Health Camp

Hemoglobin status of girl students among various age groups in college

The Health camp organized on 30th and 31st of August by the Health Committee of BVC and Department of Biochemistry received a very good response from staff and students indicating health awareness among them. Apart from the teaching and non-teaching staff 108 students have got their thyroid and hemoglobin checked.

Interpretation of the data for hemoglobin among the girl students of the college revealed that,

- 71% of students who were tested were found to be non-anemic.
- 8 % of students are with mild anemia while 19% are moderately anemic.
- 2% of students are with severe anemia.

A diet plan should be followed by those who are anemic. There should be a healthful balance of iron-rich foods, such as leafy vegetables, nuts, seeds, and fortified breakfast cereals.

If left untreated, iron-deficiency anemia can cause serious health problems since having a low oxygen in the body can damage organs.

Report on Health Camp


The department of Biochemistry organized a two-day Health Camp on 20th and 21st of January, 2016. The biochemical parameters that were tested included complete blood picture, lipid profile, creatinine, uric acid, serum calcium, Vitamin D, Vitamin B12 and thyroid profile. On 18th January, 2016 a lecture was organized by the department to give awareness to the staff regarding the clinical significance of different tests to be conducted during the health camp. The staff was made aware by a lecture why the tests were chosen and what the increased or decreased levels in the blood indicate. The camp received a good response with 79 staff members and students getting their blood parameters tested. Blood Hemoglobin levels were done free of cost to 200 girl students to assess their anemic condition. Body mass index and blood grouping were also done for the students.

International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking-26th June 2016

The United Nations General Assembly in 1987 decided to observe 26 June as the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking as an expression of its determination to strengthen action and cooperation to achieve the goal of an international society free of drug abuse.

The theme for 2017 is: "**Listen First** - Listening to children and youth is the first step to help them grow healthy and safe."

The United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) selects themes for the International Day and launches campaigns to raise awareness about the global drug problem. Health is the ongoing theme of the world drug campaign.

The South African government and its partners are implementing the National Drug Master Plan, 2013-2017, which is a collective effort towards a South Africa that is free of drug abuse. The drug master plan is a single document covering all national concerns regarding drug control; summarizing national policies authoritatively, and defining priorities and allocating responsibility for drug control efforts (United Nations Drug Control Programme). The National Drug Master Plan prioritizes strategies on demand reduction, supply reduction and harm reduction.

The Master Plan serves as the country's blueprint for preventing and reducing alcohol and substance abuse and its associated social and economic consequences on South African society, and builds on the foundation laid down by government's Programme of Action on alcohol and substance abuse.

The key outcomes of the five-year National Drug Master Plan are:

- 1. Reduction of the bio-socio-economic impact of substance abuse and related illnesses on the South African population
- 2. Ability of all people in South Africa to deal with problems related to substance abuse within communities

- 3. Recreational facilities and diversion programmes that prevent vulnerable populations from becoming substance dependents.
- 4. Reduced availability of substance dependence-forming drugs and alcoholic beverages.
- 5. Development and implementation of multi-disciplinary and multi-modal protocols and practices for integrated diagnosis and treatment of substance dependence and co-occurring disorders and for funding such diagnosis and treatment.

To bring awareness on this issue our college NSS unit conducted a rally in collaboration with NCC unit of our college and Department of Police, Neredmet X road. There were **200 volunteers (students) participated** in the rally. We conducted a rally from BVC to Sainikpuri to BVC. ALL the volunteers (200)were participated enthusiastically. 

Day -5 (08/03/2017)




Day -6 (09/03/2017)





around 2:30pm and continued till 4:30pm. Volunteers were provided driving tricks using vehicles and simulators.





The Student coordinators Bhagya Lakshmi, PranayKumar and Kiran read out the main schedule for the one week camp and the motive of the camp to the dignitaries.






Village Survey
