A REPORT ON

Paying homage to the universal legend of peace and empowering leader, Mahatma Gandhi and commemorating his 150th Birth Anniversary, Bhavan's Vivekananda College, Sainikpuri,Secunderabad, organized a series of literary and cultural events, three months before the occasion. Announcement regarding the proposal to conduct programmes was made in the first week of July 2019 and scheduling of the events was done following the enrollment of the students. The events included poster presentation, elocution competition, talk, skit, essay writing competition and a play. The motto the initiative was the revival of the Gandhian values- Truth and non-violence and the reiteration of his legacy.

Poster Presentation

The first event in the series was the poster presentation competition which was organized on **Saturday**, **20th July 2019 at** the Science Quadrangle.
