- ➤ It was discussed that EVS is an awareness course.

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Suggestions made by Board members in detail:

Supporting her statement she said for example allotting 60% for Discipline Specific Courses and the remaining 40% for Electives. She suggested to cross verify these percentages with the university.

- She suggested including activities like Hackathon and Application Development as part of the BCA club activities.
