The following points were discussed as per the agenda and resolved as follows:

Review of B.Sc (Biochemistry) Curriculum of Semesters II, IV and VI:

It was decided that the syllabus of these semesters would be followed as approved in the earlier BoS meeting without any changes.

The employability of the Core/Elective Courses, SEC and GE courses of B.Sc (Biochemistry) were discussed and approved.

1. BC 234 Biomolecules-II

Good knowledge on biomolecules of proteins and nucleic acids of this paper help students to carry out related laboratory tests in food and beverage industries and other analytical labs.

2. BC434 Biochemical Techniques and Metabolism of amino acids and nucleotides

Knowledge on techniques of colorimetry, spectrophotometry, chromatography and electrophoresis help students to work with equipment available at diagnostic centres, pharma industries or set up a small scale instrumentation lab.

3. BC 634 Molecular biology

Training in isolation, estimation and analysis of nucleic acids will enable students to work in molecular biology labs.

4. BC 634A Immunology and Nutrition

Practical skills on various immunotechniques provide opportunities for employment in molecular diagnostic labs.

Estimations and analysis of various food samples enable students to fit in food analytical labs.

5. SE 434 Basic of Food and Nutrition

Students can find employability in food related industries.

6. SE 634 Computational Biochemistry

Students will find employment in contract research organizations which provides contract research & development services in the area of bioinformatics.

Review of M.Sc Curriculum of Semester II and IV:

1. BI 201 Enzymology

The syllabus provides methods of enzyme isolation, purification, kinetic parameters and catalytic mechanisms. This knowledge is useful in purifying and marketing of enzymes by biotech companies and also useful in pharmaceutical industries where drug designing is targeted towards a particular enzyme.

2. BI 202 Molecular Biology

Students find employability in molecular biology labs of commercial or research.

3. BI 203 Biochemical Genetics & Model Organisms

The topics discussed in this paper form the basis for working in genetics labs.

4. BI 204 Biostatistics & Clinical Biochemistry

Statistical data analysis will be useful in population studies and health related studies. Sound knowledge of clinical biochemistry will help in interpreting clinical investigations in diagnostic labs

5. BI 402 Bioinformatics

The students will be able to use the knowledge in retrieving, analyzing and studying evolutionary significance of nucleic acid and protein sequences across species. This paper also introduces the students to databases that are useful in computational and drug designing labs.

6. BI 403 Biotechnology

Learning basic techniques of cell culture, vaccine production, microbial fermentation and cloning techniques will make student competent to take up employment in biotech and pharmaceutical industries.

Value added courses or certificate courses

Value added course on "Clinical Laboratory Diagnostics" is proposed and approved.

Any other points:

30 classes are allotted for each of the SEC and GE courses of which 15 classes are scheduled for theory and 15 classes for field work/practical work.

2 credits are assigned for each of these courses (SEC and GE).
