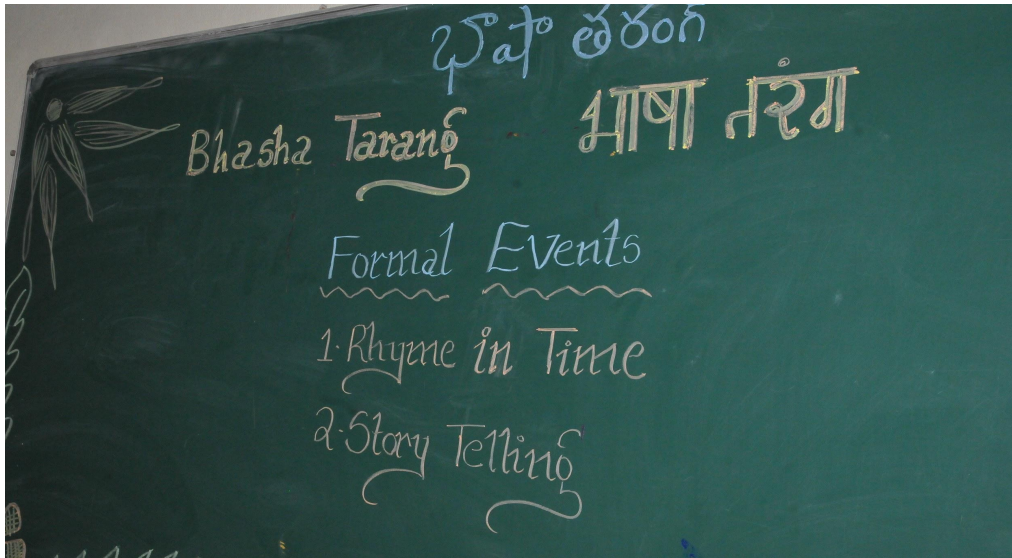
BHAVANOTSAV-2016

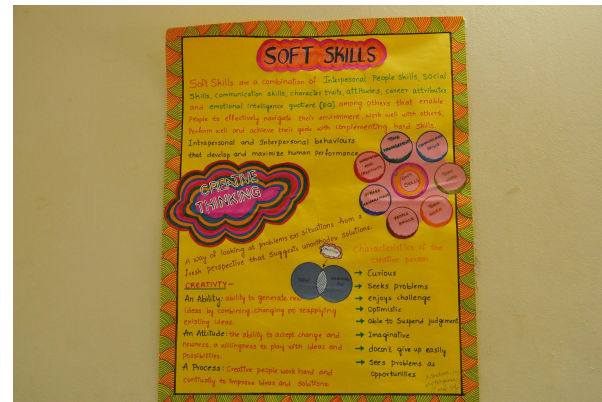
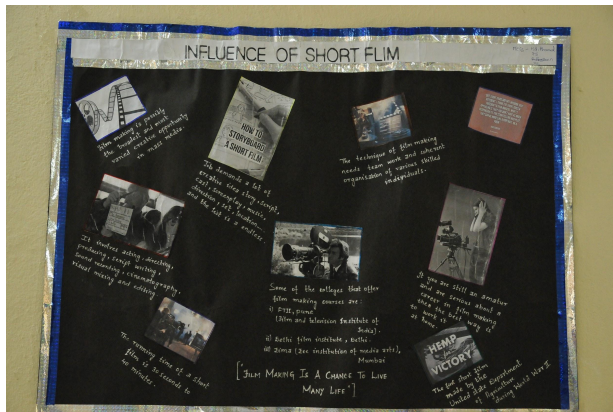
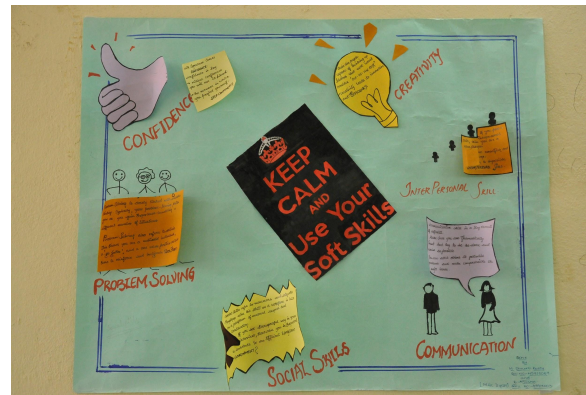
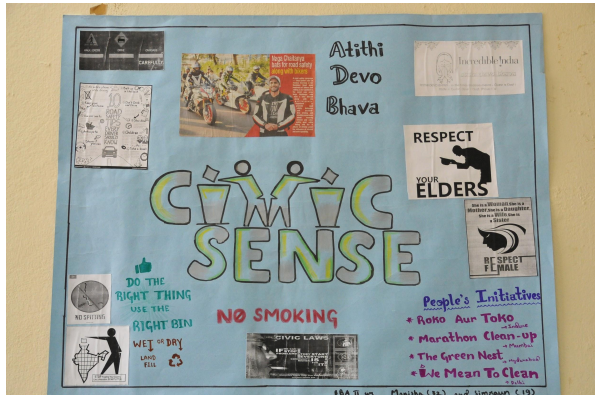
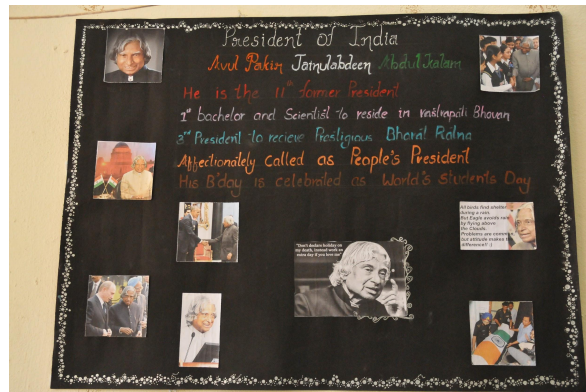
An interesting quiz event the " Word Puzzle " based on English words became an instant hit with the student audience. The program also included a medley of songs in various languages that are taught in the college.
