
## Report on Value Added Course "GENETIC DIAGNOSTIC METHODS AND COUNSELLING" 15<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2018

The students of final year M.Sc Biochemistry attended a Value Added Course from 15<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> of September, 2018 at Institute of Genetics, Begumpet, Hyderabad.
