At the end of the day, a prelim round for sub-head selection for various departments of the club was conducted.

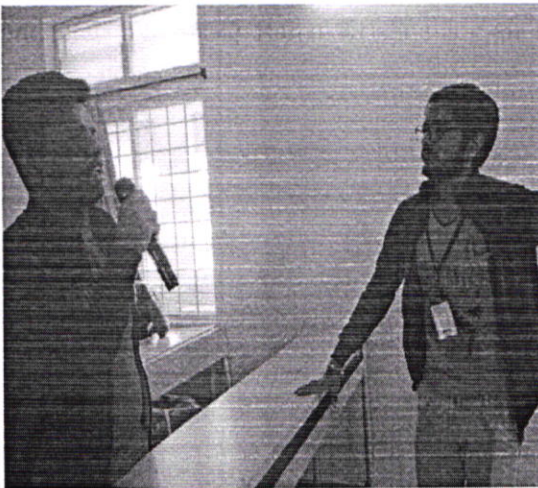
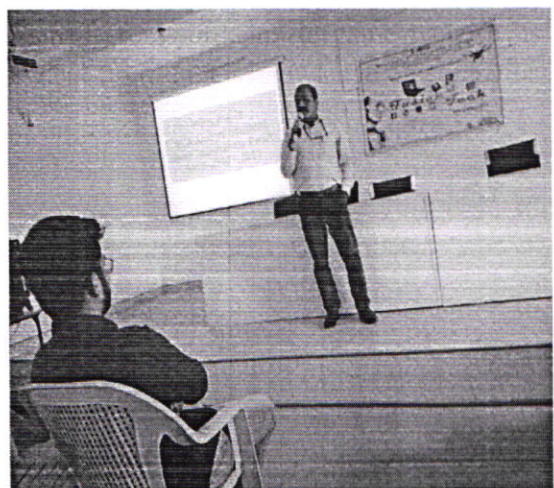
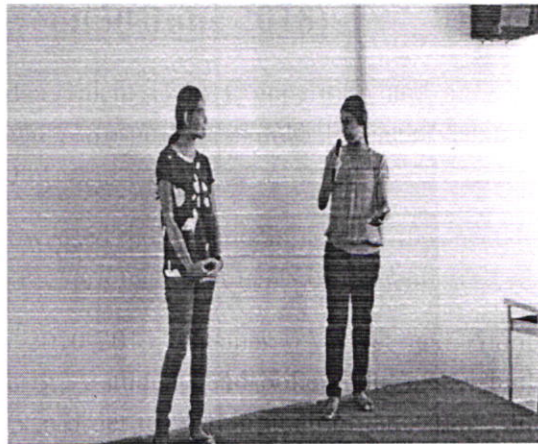
