## REPORT ON OUTREACH PROGRAM

Department of Genetics and Biotechnology of Bhavan's Vivekananda College of Science, Humanities and Commerce, Sainikpuri conducted an outreach program on 7<sup>th</sup> December 2019 for grade ten students of Zilla Parishad High School, Kapra.

The objective of the program was to provide the students with knowledge pertaining to Life Sciences, through means of practicals, which would in turn persuade the students into taking up Life Sciences as a career. Final year B. Sc students from BtGC and MGC sem VI participated in the program. Faculty Dr. B Kalpana and Dr. S. Nagamanju (Department of Genetics and Biotechnology) guided the students of B. Sc for smooth conduction of the program. The ZPHS management and staff welcomed the Bhavan's Faculty and students. They gave the school auditorium for conducting the outreach program. Students performed a total of 5 experiments and explained the basic principles about the experiments to the students of ZPHS. The experiments conducted are

- 1. Mitosis
- 2. ABO and Rh blood typing
- 3. Separation of chloroplast pigments by paper chromatography,
- 4. Demonstration of Osmosis by Potato Osmoscopy
- 5. Observation of Permanent slides.

To explain the concepts of practicals the students made use of charts prepared by them at college itself a week prior to the outreach program. Students made all the necessary preparations a day prior to the outreach program like solvents, solutions and buffers. On the day of the event they freshly made the leaf extracts and root tips. Students under the guidance of the faculty a practical manual for all the experiments conducted with the principle and procedure along chemicals information was compiled and spiral bound and handed over to the school management for the benefit of the school students.

Students were divided into groups of six and were demonstrated the experiments by Bhavan's college students. School students showed great enthusiasm in knowing the basic science experiments and noted down the information given to them. Many grade ten students even drew diagrams of the permanent slides they have seen.

At the end of the session the school management felt very thankful to the management of the Bhavan's college for conducting such valuable outreach program for their students.Final year students of Bhavan's also thanked the department of Genetics and Biotechnology for giving them an opportunity to be part of the program and share their knowledge with the enthusiastic school students and motivate them towards Life sciences.

### **CYBER SECURITY & ETHICAL HACKING**

#### Day 1

This Session focused on "Cyber Security, Remedies and Research". The Speaker, Mr. M Krishna spoke on the various types of Malware attacks and also suggested some remedies to overcome the attacks.

The third session and last session of the day was a "Hands-on Session" headed by **Mr. Giridhar Duggirala**, **Principal Architect at Wells Fargo Pvt. Ltd.** This session has been very interesting and useful and gave a practical experience on Ethical Hacking to the participants.

#### Day 2

The 2<sup>nd</sup> day started with a Video Conference talk with **Mr. Barry Nester CEO**, Board Director, **ARMOR Scientific, USA** about "Cyber Security". The Speaker addressed the current issues in the Cyber world. He also suggested remedies to overcome attacks on User Credentials. He suggested using Multi-Factor Authentication such as passwords along with biometrics.

The second session was on "Darknet Technology" where the speaker, Mr. Vinod Babu (Cyber Security Researcher and Trainer), spoke to the audience on "Dark Web" and "Deep Web". The speaker mainly focused on the critical causes of information breach and security vulnerabilities that most of us are not aware.

The next session was conducted post lunch where a panel of 5 members Dr. M.V. Ramanamurthy, Professor and Head, Dept of Mathematics& Humanities, MGIT, Hyd, Dr. Sri

Venkatesh Muktevi, Associate Professor, Dept of CS, GITHAM University, Vishakapatanam, A.P, Ms. Shanthi Nimmagadda, Security Architect, IBM Security Services, Hyd, Mr. K. Vishwanath, Vice President, Mahee Consulting Services Incorporation, Mr. K. Maruthi Prasad, Inspector of Police and also alumni of BVC, Mr. N. Bhaskar, Lecturer in Dept. of CS discussed on the topic "Opportunities and Challenges in Cyber Security and Ethical Hacking". It was an interactive session where the Panel members shared their views on Cyber Security and Ethical Hacking. ### Health Camp-2019

The Medical and Health Committee of BVC in association with Department of Biochemistry organized a health camp for the staff and students of BVC on  $30^{\text{th}}$  and  $31^{\text{st}}$  of August, 2019. The health camp was in association with Vimta Labs, Hyderabad. The tests in this health camp included Master Health checkup, Complete Health checkup, Diabetic screening, complete blood picture, glycosylated hemoglobin, fasting blood glucose, lipid profile, thyroid profile, calcium, uric acid, vitamin D and B<sub>12</sub> levels. These parameters are useful in assessing and having a follow up with ones' general health condition. A total of 155 people that included teaching (33), non-teaching staff (14) and students (108) got their tests done.

The health camp received a very good response from staff and students indicating an emerging health awareness among them.

#### Hemoglobin status of girl students among various age groups in college

The Health camp organized on 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> of August by the Health Committee of BVC and Department of Biochemistry received a very good response from staff and students indicating health awareness among them. Apart from the teaching and non-teaching staff 108 students have got their thyroid and hemoglobin checked.

Interpretation of the data for hemoglobin among the girl students of the college revealed that,

- 71% of students who were tested were found to be non-anemic.
- 8 % of students are with mild anemia while 19% are moderately anemic.
- 2% of students are with severe anemia.

A diet plan should be followed by those who are anemic. There should be a healthful balance of iron-rich foods, such as leafy vegetables, nuts, seeds, and fortified breakfast cereals.

If left untreated, iron-deficiency anemia can cause serious health problems since having a low oxygen in the body can damage organs.

The program started at 9.30 with a formal inauguration by Air.cmdre (Retd).J.L.N.Sastry, Vice Chairman, BVB Kendra, Prof.Y.Ashok, Principal,Bhavans Vivekananda Collge and Dr. K.Anuradha, Coordinator, DBT-Star college scheme. They briefed on importance of Hands on activities for science teachers. All the teachers were grouped in to three batches and assigned to three departments Chemistry, Biochemistry and Microbiology on rotational basis, where they were trained on different experiments proposed.

Department of Chemistry trained teachers on Green chemistry methods. The experiments included were Use of Curcumin instead of Nessler's reagent for testing the presence of ammonium ion; use of Thioacetamide in place of Hydrogen sulphide for testing Cations and Microwave synthesis of Benzoic acid from Benzamide.

Experiments included in Biochemistry are for alpha amylase (digestive enzyme) from saliva, Preparation of blood smear for differential count of leukocytes, Blood grouping and cardiac cycle was demonstrated to the teachers by a working model.

Hands on activities in Department of Microbiology emphasized on Staining of bacteria by simple staining, Lactophenol cotton blue staining of fungi, Observation of root nodules for bacteroid zones and Methylene Blue reduction test for testing the quality of Milk. Also the department took initiative in bringing awareness on Foldscope-a paper microscope that comes at an affordable and cheaper price to all the schools.

#### Report on the Outreach Programme

#### 11th & 12th JULY, 2019

The department of Biochemistry has organized an outreach programme at Zilla Parishad High School for girls, Alwal on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2019. Post graduate students of Biochemistry have participated with enthusiasm and displayed models and charts related to the various concepts of biological science. On the first day (11<sup>th</sup> July, 2019) the students demonstrated various experiments like achromic point of salivary amylase, Extraction of DNA from tomato followed by its microscopic observation, lipid analysis of junk foods, Development of latent fingerprint using iodine fumes and folding of DNA. On the second day (12<sup>th</sup> July,2019), Dr. Kiranmai who was pursuing final year MBBS at MNR medical college, Sangareddy gave a talk to spread awareness about menstrual hygiene to the girl students. Following this, aspects related to nutrition, BMI, blood picture and blood grouping were explained by M.Sc students. School students were very enthusiastic to observe and learn the concepts of all these experiments.

Blood group determination and body mass index (BMI) calculations were done for 76 students of 10<sup>th</sup> standard. This programme received a good appreciation from the students and staff of the school.
