The field trip to **Ace Agro Technology** started on a good note ,where we visited commercial production of Banana and date plantlets , through Tissue Culture.

The Director of the farm, **Mr.Biju** and his coworkers accompanied the students and staff to the lab in groups. They explained the production process in detail by allowing the students to view the procedure happening inside the plant tissue culture room where inoculation of the explants and subculturing of the callus took place. The students also visited the lab where inoculated tissue cultured bottles were incubated under regular intervals of photoperiod.

Mr.Biju took special interest in explaining and allowing the students to visit the working area where medium preparation and autoclaving took place that made his commercial production outstanding.

The entire institute maintained a very clean atmosphere to avoid contamination. The students were astonished at the discipline and aseptic conditions maintained. Finally they bid farewell to the institute wholeheartedly thanking them fo the opportunity given for the visit.

Next, they visited **Raaga Foundation** which is a zoo where many species of birds and animals (reptiles, cattle, poultry, etc) were raised with personal care which paved the way to learn about animal behavior and their general instincts. Report on practical training program at the Institute of Genetics- October 2016

The students of BSc Life Sciences III year participated in the practical training program on **Diagnosis & Management of Genetic Diseases** from 13-10-16 to 29-10-16 at the Institute of Genetics & Hospital for Genetic Diseases, Hyderabad.

On the first day, inauguration program was conducted where the students were introduced to the Vision and Mission of the Premier Institute. The participants were given a brief idea about the different departments, their tasks & challenges.

The participants were grouped into four different teams & sent to the following departments on rotation:

<u>Department 1</u>: **Cell Biology:**-In this dept, students learned about Karyotyping, FISH (Fluoresence In situ Hybridization) and SKY (Spectral Karyotyping) techniques. They performed Karyotyping and FISH with their own blood samples in which they did slide preparation & chromosomal analysis by screening .There were practice sessions of matching homologous chromosome pairs & numbering of chromosomes on Karyotype paper, screening for various Genetic disorders such as Turner's, Down's, Klinefelter's syndrome, etc.

<u>Department 2</u>: **Environmental Toxicology**: In this dept, students conducted cytogenetic studies to identify DNA damage due to environmental stresses, such as chromosomal aberrations, Micronucleus assay, sister chromatid exchanges & Comet assay. Students performed Comet assay with their own blood sample and analyzed DNA damage by number of DNA breaks & length of the DNA tail.

<u>Department 3</u>: **Clinical Genetics**: This dept involves diagnosis, counseling & treatment of individuals & families with Genetic disorders. The students had a slide show presentation on the diagnostic technique of Ultrasonography. The students were also involved in Genetic Counseling sessions to families affected with Genetic disorders.

<u>Department 4</u>: **Biochemistry:** In this dept, the participants learned some biochemical tests like estimation of Copper from urine Sample (for diagnosis of Wilson's disease), lipid profile from serum sample, blood Glucose levels and also Neonatal screening for genetic disorders.

<u>Department 5</u>: **Molecular Biology:** In this dept, students performed DNA isolation by Sucrose and Phenol method & they used Sucrose method to isolate DNA using their own blood samples. They did DNA separation using Agarose Gel Electrophoresis. The students also carried out PCR for amplification of desired sequences of DNA. They were briefed about the working & principle of HPLC which is used to estimate the amount of fetal hemoglobin.

The participants also had an opportunity to interact with students at the Special school for the differently abled children, which is attached to the IOG.

At the end of the training program, the students had a special session on **Career Counseling** by Prof. N.Pratibha, Director of IOG. The students were awarded participation certificates by Prof. N Pratibha. It was a very enlightening & motivating program for the students.

Report on Data Analytics

Details of Certification course in data analytics (30 hours)

Background: More & more businesses are embracing data backed decisioning. With data becoming the focal point of business strategy it becomes imperative for students to learn to work with data.

Objective: This course is meant to provide hands on inputs to the students in data analytics to ensure that they are adequately prepared for taking up related responsibilities in the corporate world.

Course content: The course will be delivered over 30 classroom hours. These 30 hours are split over four major modules:

1. Data Scrapping & Data Cleaning - 4:30 Hours

The topics to be covered under this module are sources of data and the tools required to scrape (secondary data) or collect (primary data). Hands on practice will be provided on the use of these tools.

2. Data handling - 3 Hours

This module will introduce students to structuring of data to make it ready for analysis. It will include basic procedures such as formatting, transforming, computing variables and cleaning data. It will also cover first level analysis (Frequencies, Cross tabulation and OLAP cubes).

Tools - SPSS, R, Excel

3. Data analysis – 16:30 Hours

This is the main module. It will cover analytic techniques such as Hierarchical clustering, K means clustering and Factor analysis.

Tools - SPSS, R, Excel

4. Data presentation – 4:30 Hours

Sometimes visualizing data from different perspectives leads to new insights. The Data presentation module will be interspersed between the other modules. It will cover different charts and graphs and building of interactive dash boards.

Tools - Tableau, Excel

A certification exam of 3 hours duration will be held at the end of the course (Session-20) and students who secure more than 75% marks will be issued certificate of proficiency. The certification exam will be supervised by executives of nmore. We do not issue certification of participation.
