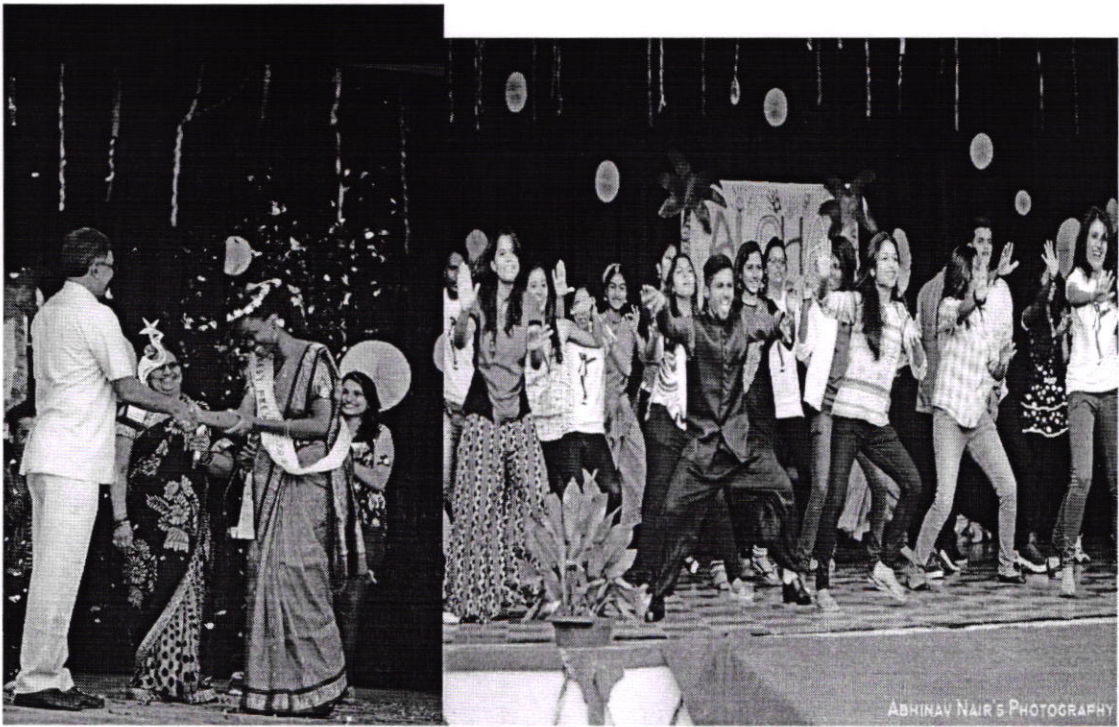
The program was organized by the Xpressionz club and ALOHA – 2016 started with bang flab mob.

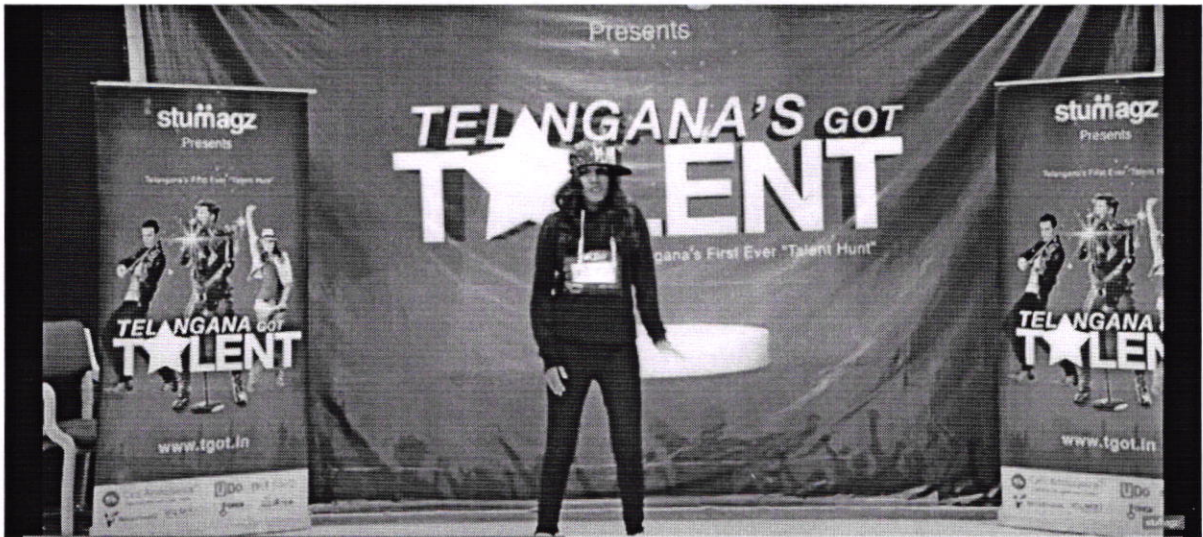

**Date: 22nd Sep2016**

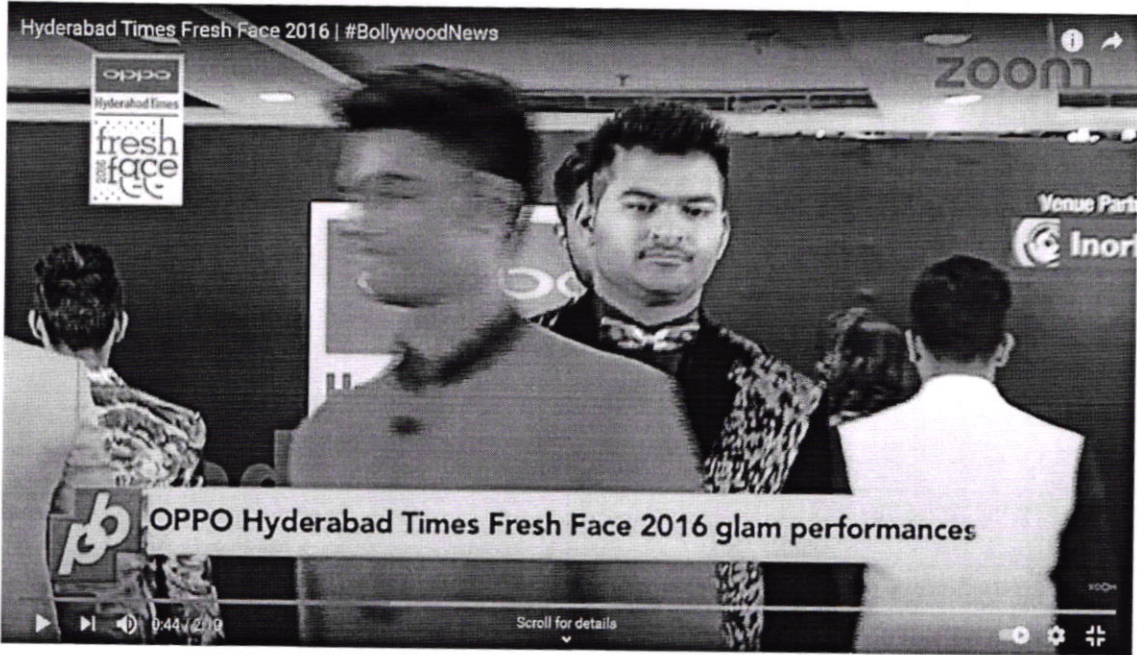

The college wore a festive look. All the students and the staff were in their traditional best in their silk sarees, ghagra cholis, flashy jewellery and in ethnic men's wear.

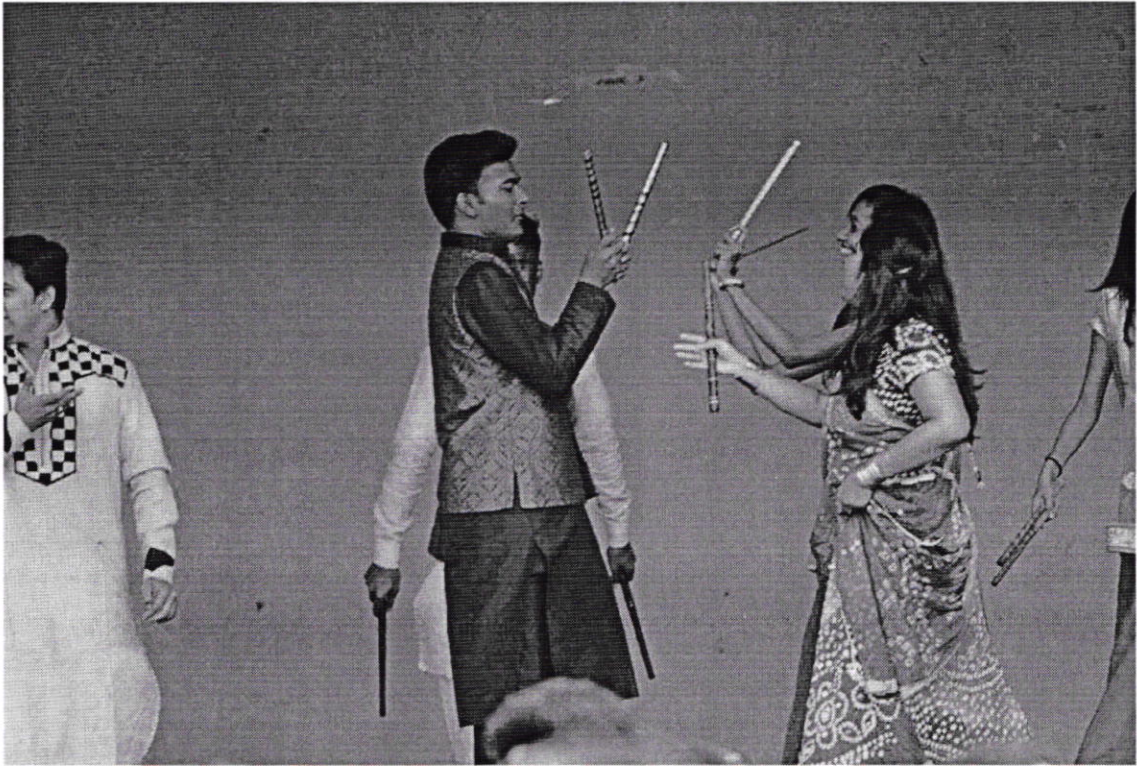
Xpressionz, the student cultural body was actively involved in organizing the festival in the college campus. Exquisite Bathukammas were prepared with beautiful floral decorations.

Art Competition – A Competition organized on different types of paintings on 3rd December 2016 which was conducted by Xpressionz club as a part of talent hunt.

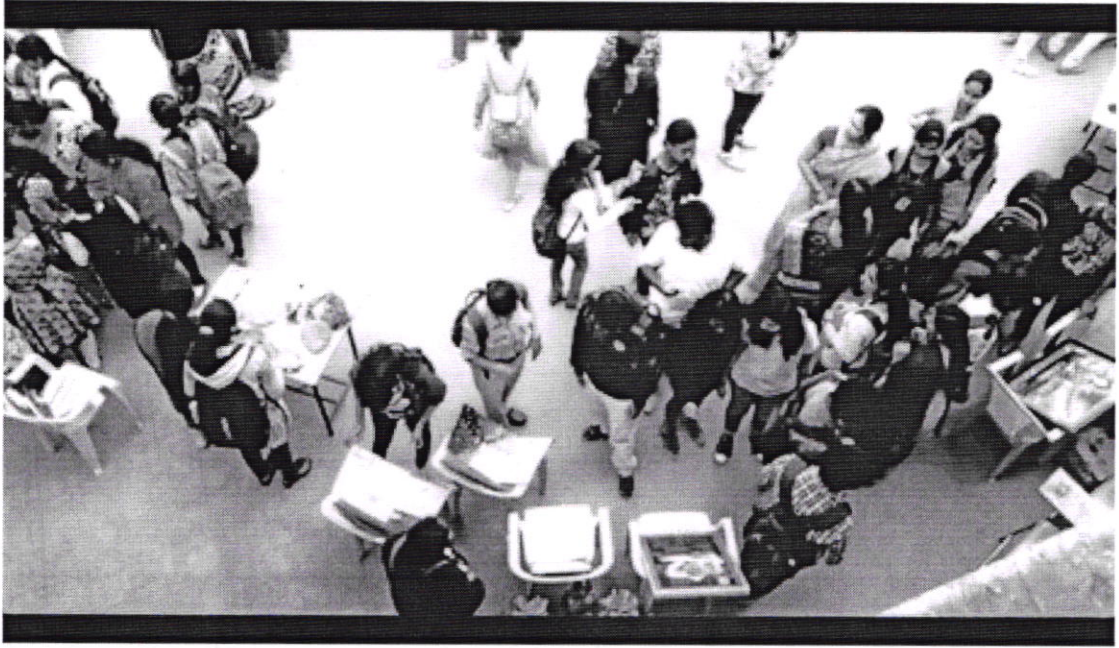
All the streams of students have enthusiastically participated in huge number to show case their marvelous and meaning full paintings.

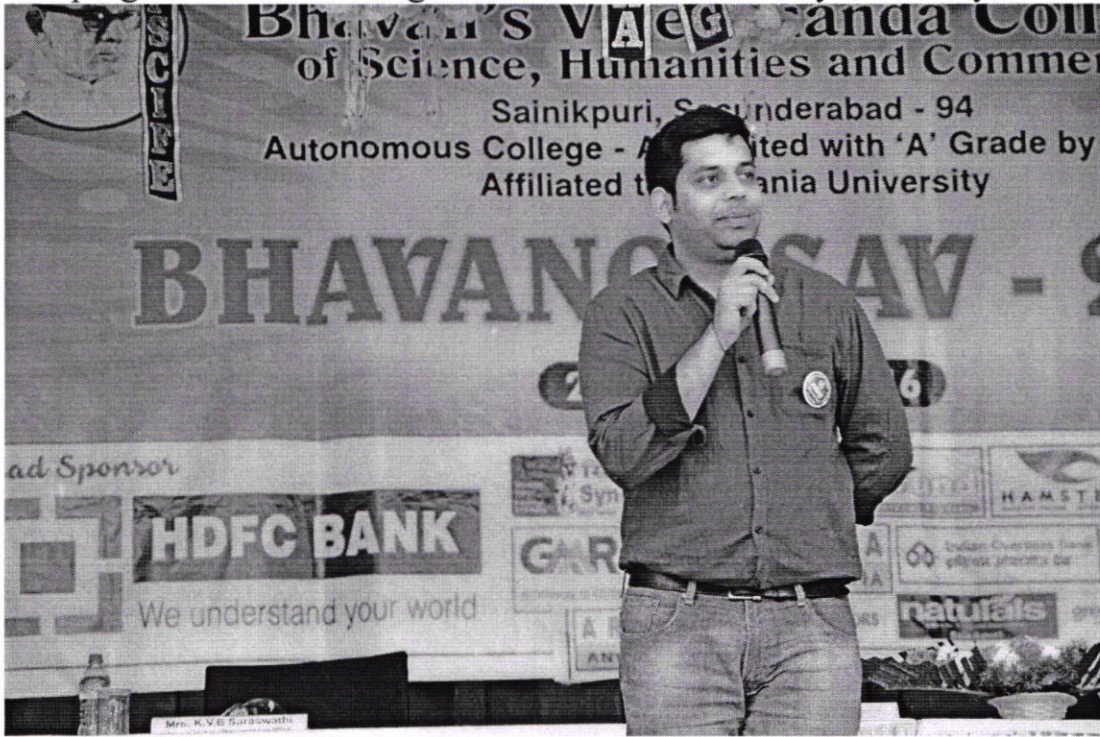

As a wrap up , there were around 36 events ,both formal and informal put together.

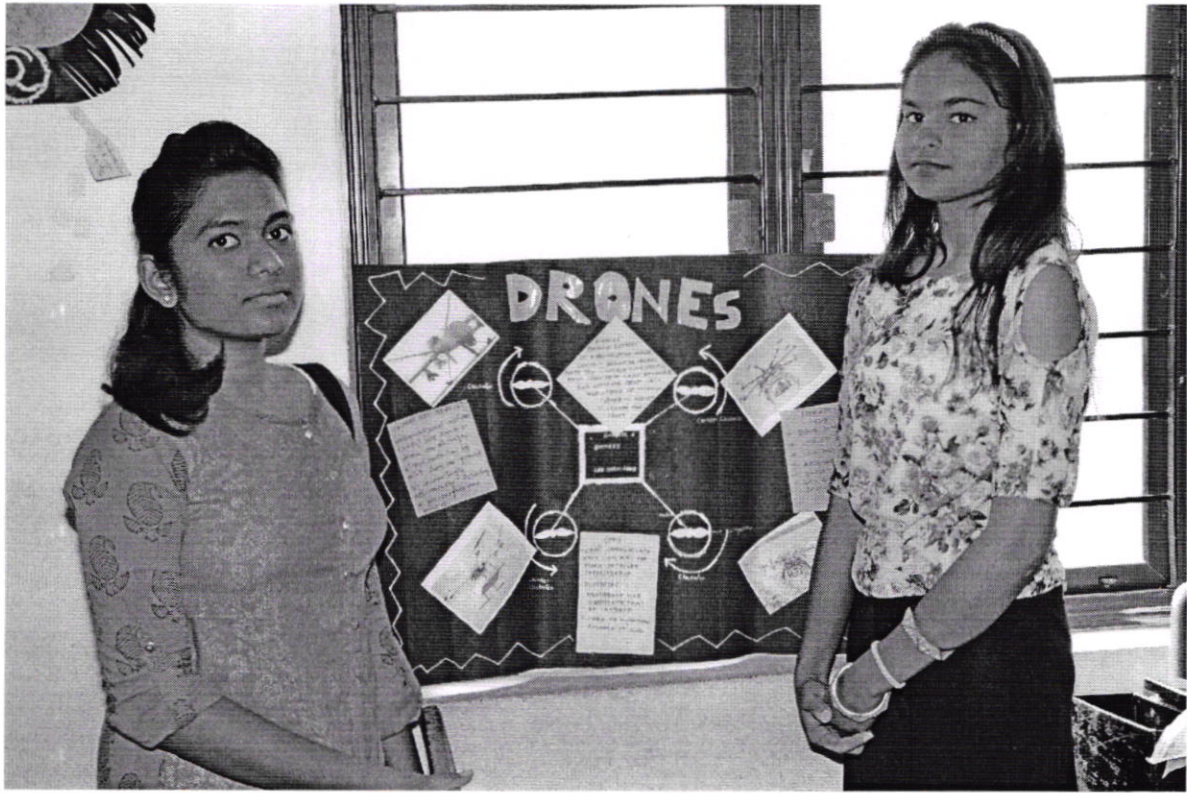

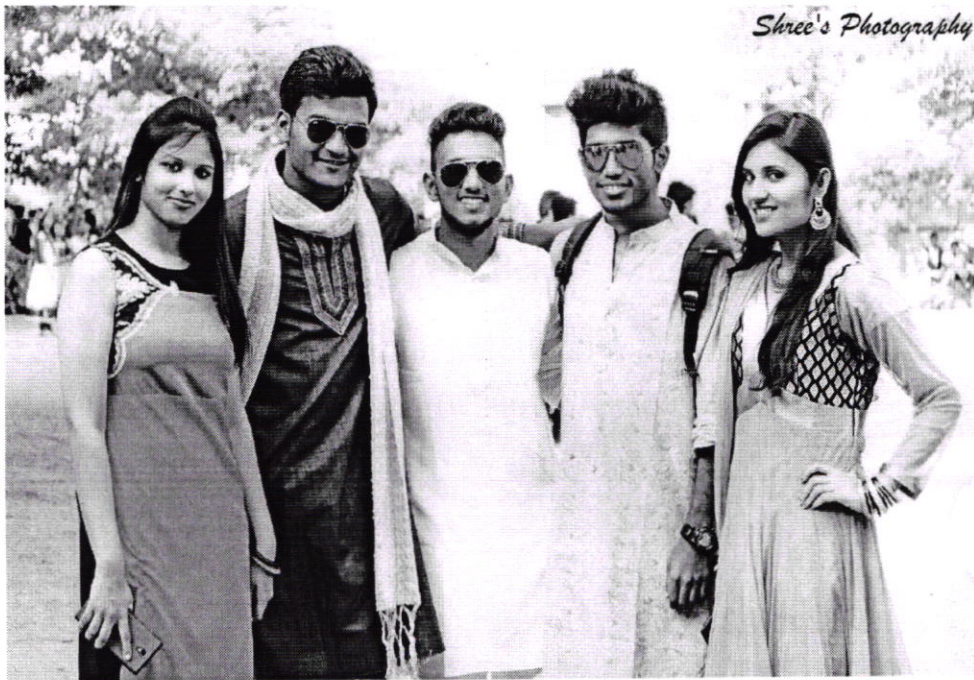
## Ethnic Week

**Date:** 31 st December 2016

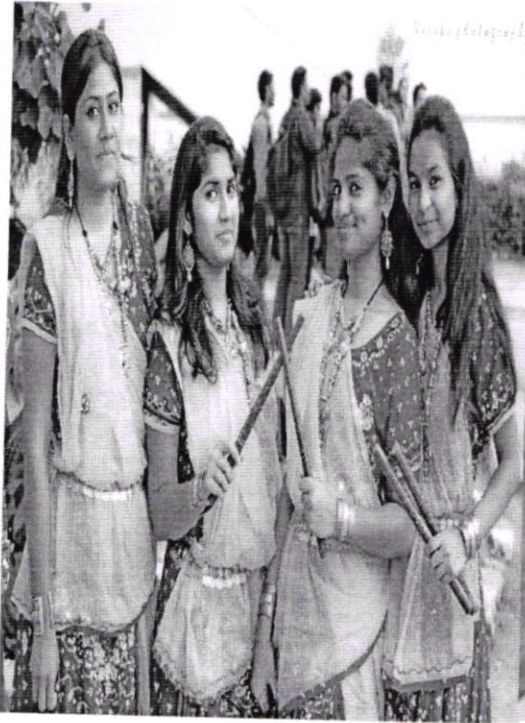
Ethnic Week is organized every year in the last week of December with a theme code as part of yuvamahotsav celebrations.

The on stage events were the highlight of the day that attracted huge crowds, cheering and applause.

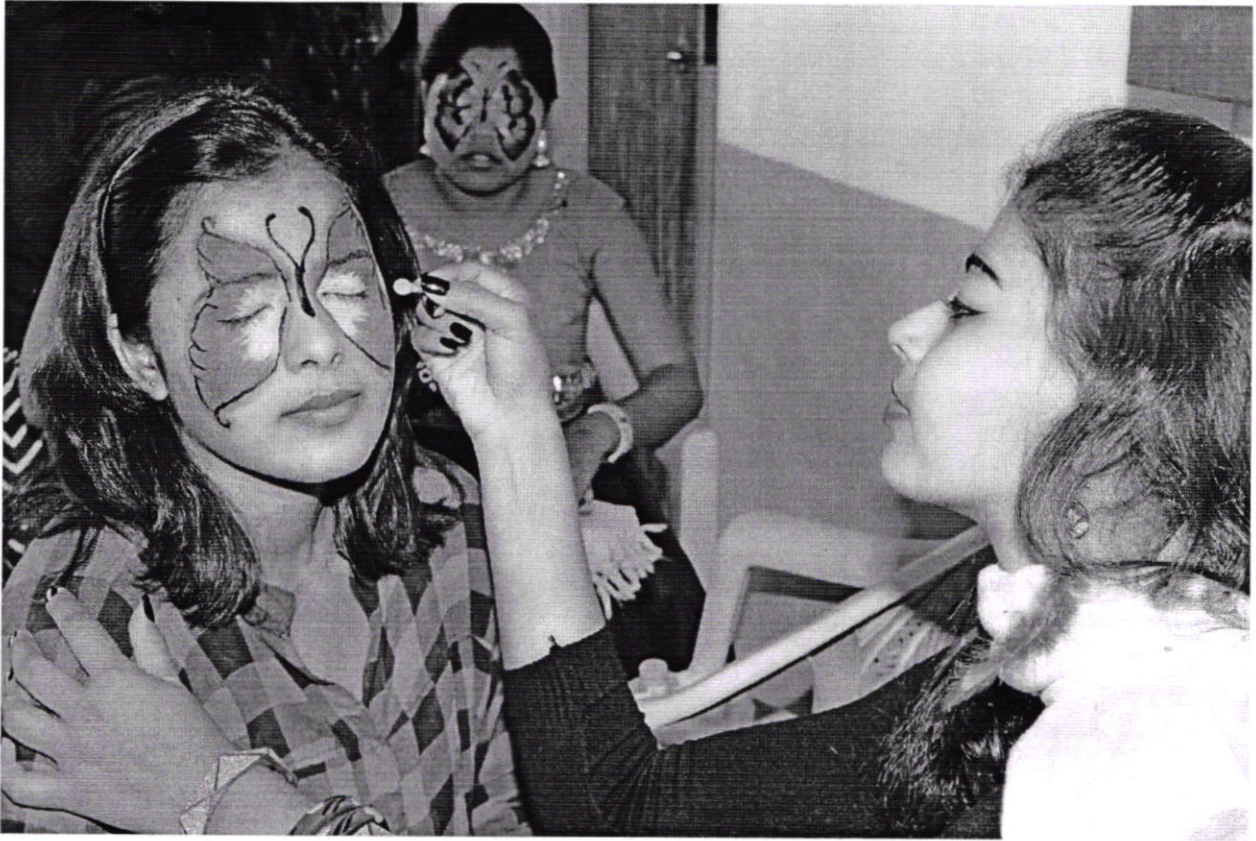

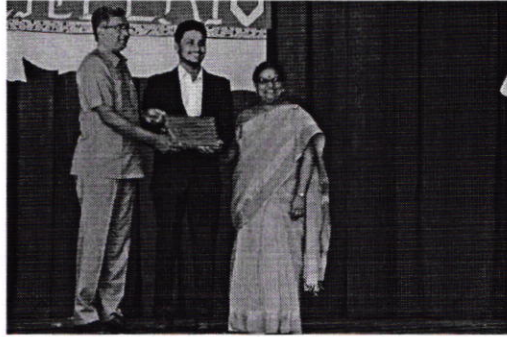


