




The program was organized by the Xpressionz club and ALOHA – 2016 started with bang flab mob.


After a series of elimination rounds, outoff 21 finalists, Ms. AJ was crowned as the "Best Promising Ms Fresher".




The college wore a festive look. All the students and the staff were in their traditional best in their silk sarees, ghagra cholis, flashy jewellery and in ethnic men's wear.

Xpressionz, the student cultural body was actively involved in organizing the festival in the college campus. Exquisite Bathukammas were prepared with beautiful floral decorations.



As a wrap up, there were around 36 events, both formal and informal put together.





Ethnic Week


Date: 31 st December 2016

30th December 2016



The chief guest declared the Yuvamahotsav Fest OPEN




The Antakshari, was a hit event with the Bhavanites.

The on stage events were the highlight of the day that attracted huge crowds, cheering and applause.


