

72nd Independence Day celebration



"SCIENCE AS WE SEE"


On 15th of Sept 2018 Department of Chemistry had organized a drawing competition open to all the students of UG & PG programme in the college.


The competition was titled as "Science as we see", where 40 students took active participation and had put forward their novel thoughts on everyday science as they see through their eyes.





Report on Science Club Activity by Department of Genetics and Biotechnology




The college magazine VIBHA-2018-19 was released by the chief guest.
