
he**Treasure hunt** was conceived for students from outside colleges. The event attracted 18 teams and 36 participants.


The Semester toppers of all PG and UG courses were awarded silver medals and certificates on this occasion.

The play traced the various stages of Gandhiji's life as follows-




Plogging Report

Students spoke eloquently on the importance of this day and paid rich tributes to our great leaders and martyrs who rendered selfless service to the nation.


This was followed by a small cultural program showcasing Indian culture and our freedom movement.






Report On FAREWELL PARTY -2020 La La Land


February 22, 2020

The college magazine VIBHA-2019-20was released by the chief guest.


This was followed by the prize distribution ceremony. All the meritorious students and student achievers in sports and NCC were awarded scholarships and mementos by the chief guest.


