GUEST LECTURE ON "SIX SIGMA"

The Department of Management Studies organized a guest lecture on "SIX SIGMA" on 18th August 2018, Saturday at Bhavans Vivekananda College, in the seminar hall for MBA II year students. The speaker for the seminar was Mr. Ronak Kothari.

Mr Ronak is currently working as Portfolio Administrator at Franklin Templeton; He had also worked as a senior customer service associate at Amazon Development Centre India. He's an alumnus of Bhavans College.

The lecture began with the definition of six sigma and its evolution. He explained about the characteristics, stages /levels of certification. A lot of interaction was seen during the lecture.
