REPORT

On the occasion of World AIDS Day, the Youth Red Cross (YRC) unit of Bhavan's Vivekananda College organized an AIDS Awareness Program on 1st December to educate the public about HIV/AIDS and its modes of transmission. As part of the initiative, a rally was conducted from Neredmet Crossroads to the college, with volunteers preparing placards carrying slogans on awareness, prevention, and misconceptions. The rally aimed to reach the local community, encourage

open conversations about HIV, and reduce social stigma associated with the disease.

Participants assembled at the Neredmet Crossroads Bus Stand by 8:00 a.m., and the rally began at 8:15 a.m. with students raising slogans and spreading key messages. Their coordinated movement through the main streets attracted the attention of commuters and residents, helping the message reach a wider audience. The march concluded at 9:00 a.m. at Bhavan's Vivekananda College, followed by an informative session by YRC members on how HIV spreads, common myths, preventive methods, and the importance of early testing. Additional emphasis was placed on safe practices, available treatment options, and the need for compassion towards individuals living with HIV.

The program concluded by 9:30 a.m., with the dedication and discipline of the volunteers ensuring its smooth execution. Their teamwork made the AIDS Awareness Program a meaningful and impactful initiative by the Youth Red Cross, promoting both awareness and social responsibility among the students and the community.
