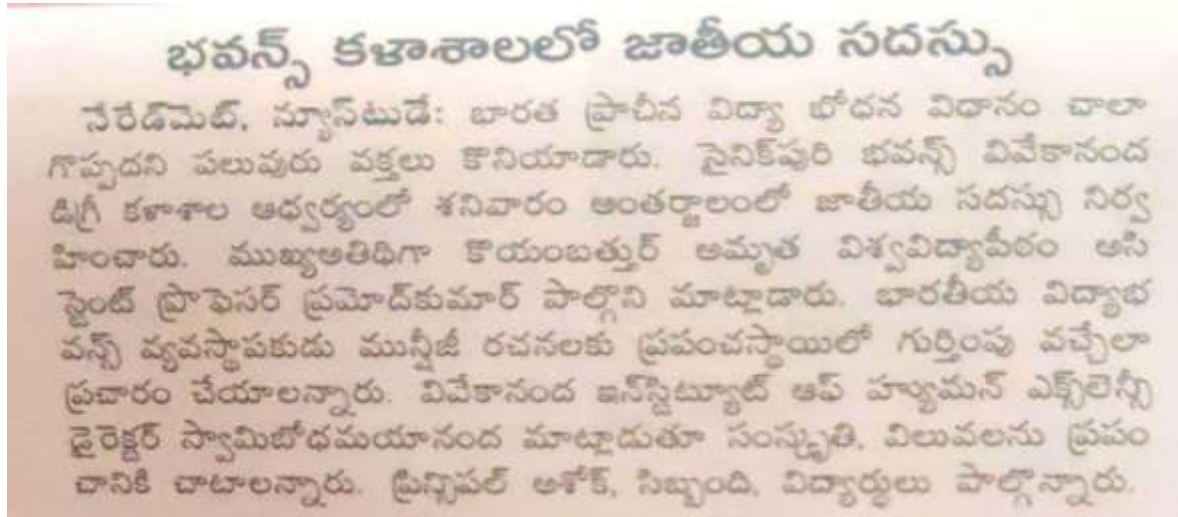

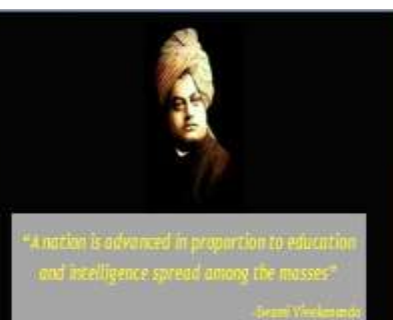

### **REPORT ON A VISIT TO RAMAKRISHNA MATH**

The Students of 2<sup>nd</sup> year of

visited Ramakrishna math on 4<sup>th</sup> April, Monday.

The surroundings were pleasant; carvings, paintings and idols of Swami Vivekanandawere very attractive. Carvings of Kurukshetram was a delight to the eyes. The introduction video which was played could let us know what exactly is the motto of Ramakrishna Math and how they give importance not only in teaching students Indianlanguages, but also foreign languages such as German, French, Japanese and etc.

Amoha Chaitanya Sir had beautifully explained about monastic name, reason for having one and its meaning. He also said about his change in name from Chandan to Amoha Chaitanya. Sir also told how to judge one or make a constructive criticism. Heexplained why should one meditate i.e, for mental well-being and spiritual enlightenment. Benefits and stages of mental well being and spiritual enlightenment were very well elucidated. His idea on ego and ways to display it was precise. He also talked about fundamental concepts of truth and spirit; permanent and unchanging things; types of meditation.

Sir concluded the session by taking us to meditation hall. Sir had demonstrated “process meditation” and could get some relaxation, serene and peace. We could control our senses, posture and movement through the guidance of sir. Meditating for almost half an hour eased our body, made our mind and soul as light as a feather.

The next session was followed up by Adiraju Satyanarayana Sir. He had begun the session advising us how to be presentable. Being clean and tidy will develop confidenceand belief in ourselves. Ultimately sir had said that cleanliness is the emblem of purity of mind. Sir had also lectured us about the 5R's- Read, Re-read, Revise, Recall, Reproduce and said that “Repetition is the mother of learning”. Sir had talked about the results of meditation which include enhancing the brain's capacity, controlling blood pressure, decreasing stress and aging of brain. He also explained us about 4 main actions abbreviated as SAVE.

S- Silence

A- Affirmations

V- Visualisation



## E- Exercise

He even instructed us to follow the 5 positive affirmations for well-being. They are:

- 1) My memory is great
- 2) I am Passionate
- 3) I am Confident
- 4) I am energetic
- 5) I am healthy

He had displayed videos regarding the mediation, being kind to others and laughing therapy. He had concluded the session saying “Smile is the best ornament one human can have” and “Make-up is incomplete without wearing a pleasant smile on the face”.

The final session of personality or physical development was dealt by Ramya ma’am with bundle of energy. She has shared many incidents from her life which made her to believe in spirituality. She had given an example of a person crossing the road by himself after several attempts, which could build self confidence and trust in him/herself. She had also taught that personality development starts from us and ends with others. She had also given us an example of water boiling in 4 different bowls containing potato, egg, rice and tea leaves in each. When ma’am asked our opinion about the end result, we could figure out that each substance is moulding its shape or transforming itself to get convenient, except for tea leaves which was giving out or donating itself to make water rich in flavour. So as humans should act in such a way which can develop our personality. Ma’am expressed that we get more happiness when we make someone happy. She also told “How you make others feel about themselves says a lot about you”.

The session was very interactive and lively for the only possible reason of ma’am’s enthusiasm and spirit.

The team conducted a feedback session, where we shared our experience and some of incidents of our lives. The session taught us that there are many reasons to be happy and to do whatever makes our soul happy.

The students were served with lunch in conventional way and then clicked few pictures. They also visited library and bought few books.

Overall, the students enjoyed the session. They found it very amazing session and are grateful to the management of Bhavan’s Vivekananda College for teaching them moral values and life skills in addition to the subjects.

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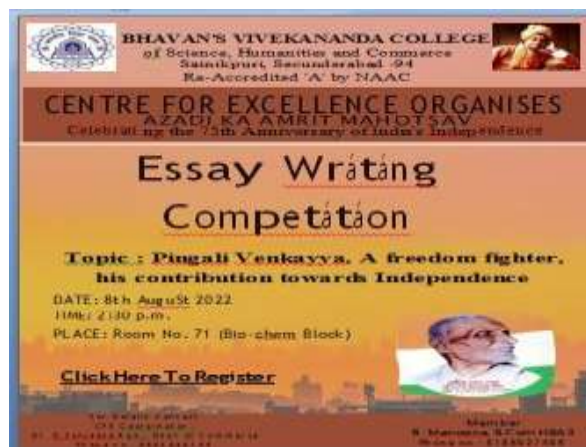
