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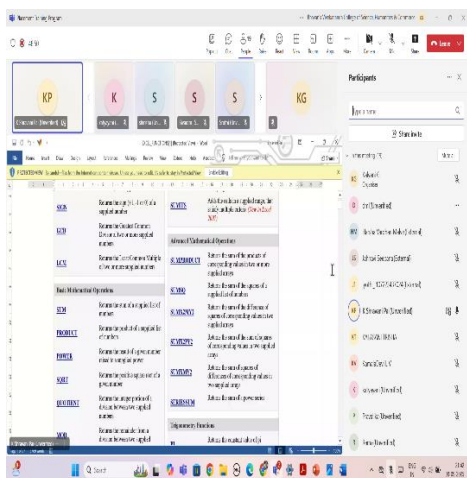
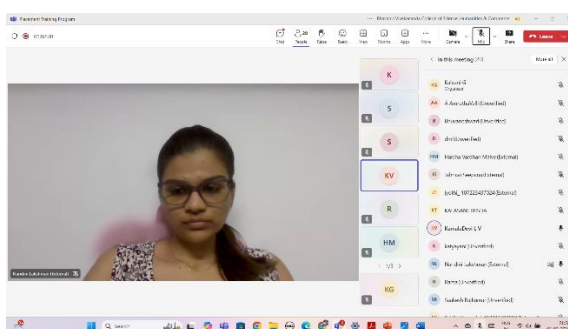
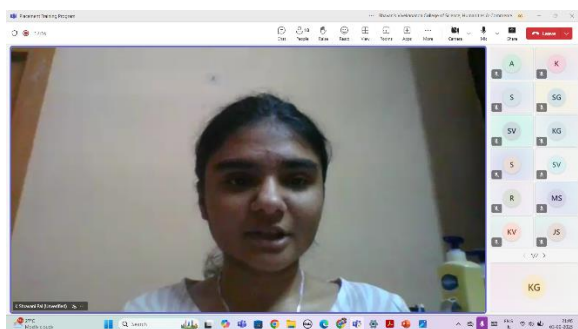
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ONLINE ALUMNI TALK

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CYBER CRIME AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The Department of Commerce, Bhavan's Vivekananda College organized a guest lecture on "Cyber Crime Awareness". The session began with a welcome address by the Head of the Department, highlighting the importance of digital safety in today's online environment.

The guest speaker, D. Kanta Rao, HR Manager at SBI, explained various cyber frauds such as malicious APK files, SMS phishing, OTP theft, and digital arrest scams, along with the use of social engineering techniques by cybercriminals. Students were also made aware of the cybercrime helpline (1930) and the official reporting portal. RJ Ravali from Red FM, another guest of the day, highlighted the importance of being cautious about online transactions and awareness of cybercrimes through fun games. The program was informative and well received by the students.





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Guest Lecture on Sentiment Analysis and Engagement Analysis

The Department of Commerce organized a guest lecture on *Sentiment and Engagement Analysis* on 18 February 2026 for the final year students of B.Com (Honours) Business Analytics. The session was conducted at N4, Library Block, and was attended by 50 enrolled students. The lecture was delivered by Dr. V. Sree Pavani, an experienced academician in Marketing and Business Analytics.

Dr. Pavani began the session by introducing students to the growing importance of Social Media Analytics in today's digital world. She explained in a simple and engaging manner how businesses collect and analyse data from platforms like Facebook and Instagram to understand customer opinions and behaviour. She also discussed how sentiment analysis helps categorize feedback into positive, negative, and neutral responses, enabling companies to evaluate brand perception and customer satisfaction. Further, she spoke about engagement metrics such as likes, shares, comments, and reach, and explained how these indicators help organizations measure the effectiveness of their marketing campaigns. By connecting theory with practical examples, she made complex analytical concepts easy and relatable for students.

The session was interactive and encouraged students to think about how analytics can be applied in real business scenarios. Overall, the lecture was insightful, engaging, and highly beneficial for the students' academic learning and practical understanding.



Bhavan's Vivekananda College Honours U-19 World Cup Hero Aaron George Varghese

Hyderabad, February 16, 2026: Aaron George Varghese, India Under-19 cricketer and first-year B. Com student at Bhavan's Vivekananda College, Sainikpuri, returned to campus for a special felicitation on Monday to celebrate his pivotal role in India's 2026 ICC U-19 World Cup triumph.

The event, attended by Principal Dr. G.S.V.R.K. Choudhary, faculty, and students, highlighted George's semi-final heroics: an unbeaten 115 against Afghanistan despite an elbow injury, earning Player of the Match and powering a record 311-run chase—the second-highest Indian score in U-19 World Cup semifinals. India defeated England by 100 runs in the final. Anchors Smaran and Sahithi from BCom Finance recounted his 2025 ACC Asia Cup exploits (228 runs, including 69 vs UAE and 85 vs Pakistan) and domestic leadership, captaining Hyderabad U-19 to the Vinoo Mankad Trophy title.

Dr. G.S.V.R.K. Choudhary, Principal, said, "I am proud of Aaron for winning the U-19 World Cup and congratulate him on his remarkable achievement. Continue working hard, reach greater heights, and aim for selection in the senior national team." The programme included speeches, felicitation by Vice Principal Prasanna and HODs, and a photo session.

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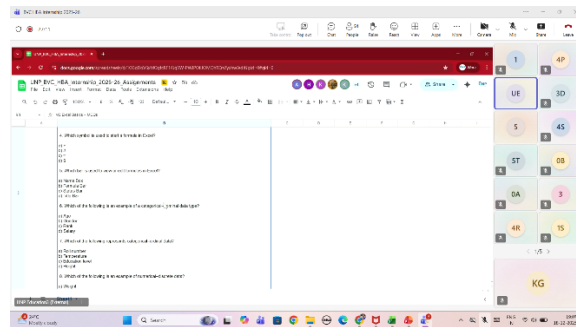
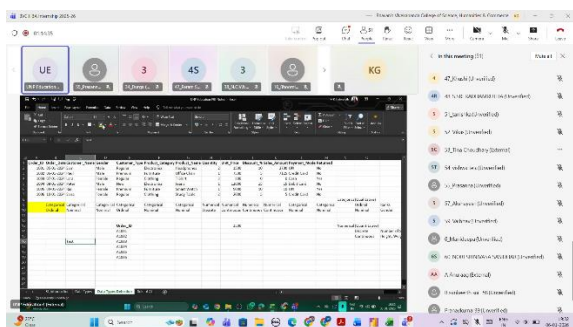
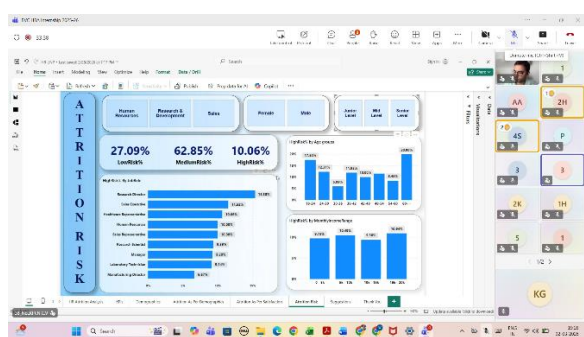
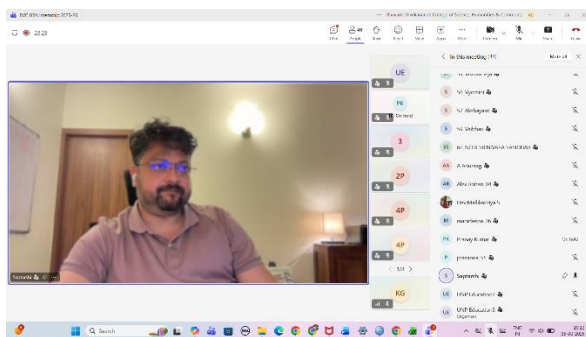




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Internship by UNP for B Com 2HBA students

The United Network of Professionals conducted a Business Analytics Internship Program from 16th December 2025 to 25th March 2025, for BCom Honors (Business Analytics) students as a part of the curriculum, providing them with comprehensive training in Advanced Excel, Microsoft Power BI, and MySQL.
