Research Workshop

On the 19th and 20th of August, the Dept. of Psychology, Faculty of Arts organized a two day workshop conducted by Ms. Shraddha Pradip Namjoshi. The workshop started sharply at 10:00 AM, with the enthusiastic participation of the Ba-3 students. The first day began with an insightful introduction to the fundamentals of research , what research truly means, how to frame the right questions, and the methods to conduct it. The session was a mix of theory and practical learning. During the practical segment, students were divided into groups and assigned tasks that encouraged collaboration and application of concepts learned in the theory class. Day-1 concluded on a positive and engaging note, leaving students inspired. It started with Introduction to Social Science Research and carried forward with Types and Methods of Research, Formulating a Research Question, Literature Review Basics, Objectives of Research, Choosing a Suitable Research Method, Ethics in Research and ended with a Group Activity.

The second day started with Data Collection, Population & Sampling, Analysis of Data, interpretation of Data, Research Report Format, References and Bibliography, Publication, Hands-on Activity: Research Project Plan and Group Presentations. It was followed with discussions on analyzing and interpreting research, research ethics, and practical approaches to handling data. And at the last, Ms. Shraddha guided each student to frame a research question of their own and draft a plan . The students participated with great enthusiasm, showing creativity and critical thinking. The workshop concluded successfully, leaving students with a broader and clearer understanding of research work, a foundation that will greatly benefit them in their final semester and beyond.
