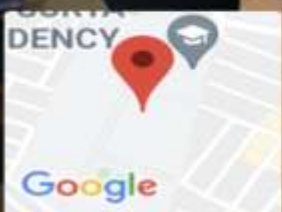

Free Medical Camp

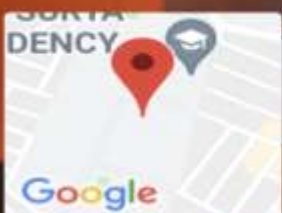
30-10-2021

The free medical camp was organized in association with Dhanavantari Hospital, Temple Alwal, Secunderabad. The test included Bone mineral testing, Random blood glucose testing and consultation with Diabetologist and General physicians. The camp received a huge response with 143 members participating and utilizing the health services. There were 122 staff members and 21 members from the community around the college. The camp started at 10.00 am in the morning and continued till 1.00 pm. The free medical camp received a good response and was well appreciated by the staff and community who participated.

2020-21 Health Camp

20th and 21st November, 2020

The Medical and Health Committee of BVC in association with Department of Biochemistry organized a health camp for the teaching and non-teaching staff of BVC on 20th and 21st of November, 2020. The health camp was in association with Vimta Labs, Hyderabad. The list of tests in the health camp included Master Health checkup, Complete Health checkup, Diabetic screening, complete blood picture, HbA1C, fasting blood glucose, lipid profile, thyroid profile, calcium, uric acid, Vitamin D and B₁₂ levels. During this COVID-19 pandemic, evaluating the levels of all health parameters especially vitamin D and B₁₂ are considered to be important to fight against infections.

A total of 39 teaching and non-teaching staff from the college have got various parameters tested. It was observed that there were 26 staff members who have got their Master Health Check done. This profile includes all the tests associated with the functioning of the vital organs. While rest of the staff have got tested for profiles like either Complete Health Checkup or Sunshine vitamin screening profile showing their awareness and importance of the camp. Overall, the health camp received a very good response from staff even during this pandemic time.





2019-2020

**Free Diabetes camp
15th February, 2020**

Medical and Health committee along with the Department of Biochemistry and NSS unit, BVC organized a medical camp on diabetes for teaching and non-teaching staff, students and residents of the local community on 15th February, 2020. As a part to create awareness there was a talk organized by Dr.K. Srinivas Rao, Diabetologist on “Risk factors and prevention of Diabetes”. This was followed by free testing of random blood glucose levels for all the participants. All the participants availed the free service and the programme received a good appreciation.



Health Camp

30th and 31st August, 2019

The Medical and Health Committee of BVC in association with Department of Biochemistry organized a health camp for the staff and students of BVC on 30th and 31st of August, 2019. The health camp was in association with Vimta Labs, Hyderabad. The tests in this health camp included Master Health checkup, Complete Health checkup, Diabetic screening, complete blood picture, glycosylated hemoglobin, fasting blood glucose, lipid profile, thyroid profile, calcium, uric acid, vitamin D and B₁₂ levels. These parameters are useful in assessing and having a follow up with ones' general health condition. A total of 155 people that included teaching(33), non-teaching staff (14) and students (108) got their tests done.

The health camp received a very good response from staff and students indicating an emerging health awareness among them.





2018-2019

Health Camp

14th and 16th August, 2018

A Health camp was conducted by the Department of Biochemistry on 14th and 16th of August, 2018 for the staff and students of Bhavan's Vivekananda College. The camp was organized in association with Vimta labs. As a part of the camp various blood parameters like glucose, lipid profile, liver profile, kidney profile, complete blood count, thyroid profile, vitamin D and vitamin B12, were investigated. Complete health checkup panel, Master health checkup panel and Extended health checkup panel were included in the list of tests done apart from individual tests. About 39 staff members and 73 students got their tests done for various parameters. About 242 students got their blood group tested. There was an active involvement of students of undergraduate and postgraduate students in conducting the Health camp activities.

These health camps are successful in helping the staff and students to monitor their health status periodically and make necessary corrections in terms of diet or clinical help from a doctor. The department was appreciated by staff and students for the initiative taken and continuing the activity which has become useful at their convenience.

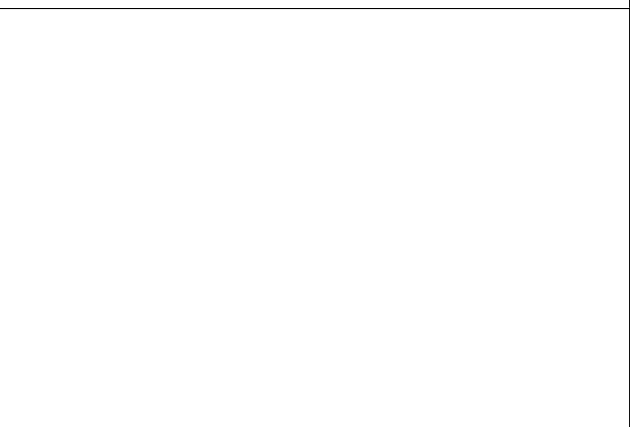




Free Dental Check-up

(28th July, 2018)

The Department of Biochemistry and the NSS unit of Bhavan's Vivekananda College, Sainikpuri, organized a free dental check-up for staff and students of the college on 28th July, 2018. This camp was organized in the college in collaboration with the Department of Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics and Department of Public Health, Army College of Dental Sciences. There were 12 doctors and 11 interns who screened staff and students' oral health. The camp received a huge response with nearly 420 students availing this free dental check-up.

Complete health checkup panel, Master health checkup panel and Extended health checkup panel were included in the list of tests done. About 33 staff members and 43 students got their tests done for various panel of tests. The health camp was successful in helping the staff and students to monitor their health status and make necessary corrections in terms of diet or clinical help from a doctor.





2016-2017

Health Camp

6th and 7th of January, 2017

A Health camp was conducted by the Department of Biochemistry on 6th and 7th of January, 2017 for the staff and students of Bhavan's Vivekananda College. The camp was organized in association with Vimta labs. As a part of the camp various blood parameters like glucose, lipid profile, liver profile, kidney profile, complete blood count, thyroid profile, vitamin D and vitamin B12, were investigated. This year Complete health checkup panel, Master health checkup panel and Extended health checkup panel were also included in the list of tests done. About 58 staff members and 115 students got their different blood parameters evaluated. The health camp received a good response and was well appreciated by the staff and students.





2015-2016

Health Camp

The department of Biochemistry organized a two-day Health Camp on 20th and 21st of January, 2016. The biochemical parameters that were tested included complete blood picture, lipid profile, creatinine, uric acid, serum calcium, Vitamin D, Vitamin B12 and thyroid profile. On 18th January, 2016 a lecture was organized by the department to give awareness to the staff regarding the clinical significance of different tests. The staff was made aware by a lecture why the tests were chosen and what the increased or decreased levels in the blood indicate. The camp received a good response with 79 staff members and students getting their blood parameters tested.

Hemoglobin levels were done free of cost to 200 girl students to assess the anemic condition. Body mass index and blood grouping were also done for the students.
