- Teams which are unable to solve the clue will be eliminated automatically.
- Each team must have a QR Scanner.

There was a volunteer at each location for the hunt to make sure there was no violation of the rules and to ensure no confusion. There were 18 teams participating, different departments, with two in each team. The hunt ended at the same place it began, the Library Block. There were 3 winning teams. The first place was backed by BCA 1<sup>st</sup> years – Siddharth and Riza. The second place was backed by BSC MPCS 2<sup>nd</sup> year students and the third place by BA students.

With perfect coordination of students and teachers, the event was a great success!







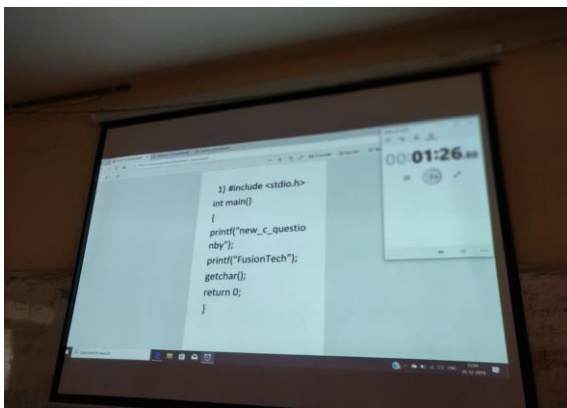

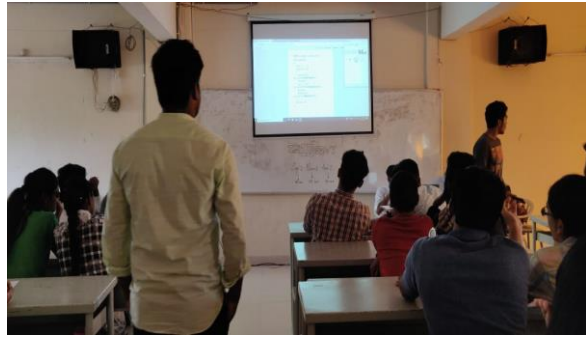
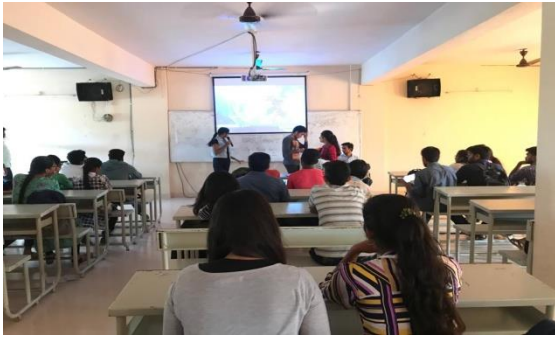
## **In10sity – Qualifiers Round**

The students who qualified for the next round were eligible for the final round to be held on Charles Babbage Day.







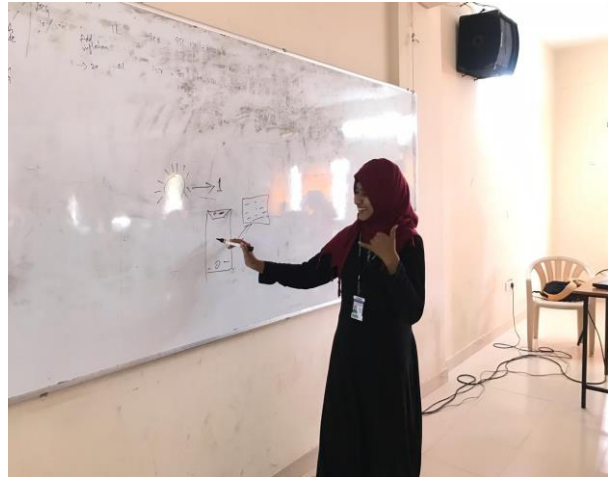
## Active Saturday Event (14<sup>th</sup> December 2019)

On 14<sup>th</sup> December 2019, FusionTech club organized its Active Saturday Event for BCA Students in Room no. N21, Library Block under the supervision of Mr. G Mahesh Kumar (BCA Coordinator and Assistant Professor in Computer Science) and Ms. N Sharon Rosy (Lecturer in Computer Science).

The first round of Heads selections for the club was conducted. The objective of this session was to judge the management and organization of the future club heads. The commencement of the program began with Pictionary. This game is a charades-inspired word guessing game. The game was played in teams of 2 with players trying to identify specific words from their teammates. This was conducted for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years.
