The Fusion Tech Club under the Department of Computer Science hosted an event named **"RUNTIME TERROR"** on **June 4 2022, exclusively** for BCA, BSc Physical Sciences, BSc-HDS of 1st, 2nd and 3rd years.

Class-to-class announcements in the above-mentioned departments were made, and registration links were sent across to the various class groups.

On-the-spot registration was also available near the IT block on campus. A total of 135 people signed up for the event.



The competition consisted of three rounds.

**Round I- Quizzard**: It was an online mode Technical Quiz. It included technology-related questions to assess the participants' technical expertise. 135 participants took part in this round. They were given questions via Google forms, which they were required to fill and submit within a given time.

**Round II- "See but can't see"**: This round had HTML code. 25 participants were qualified from round1 for this round. The participants were required to turn off their computers and input the code displayed to them within a set time limit. Based on the number of errors, and the final output which also could be approximate, participants were shortlisted for round 3.





**Round III- "You Can't C Me"**: This round began, with 18 participants qualifying from round two. It was based on C programming, and participants were shown the output of a program and had to type the code within a time limit while their screens are turned off.



Judges Mr.Saumesh Routray and Ms.J.LakshmiVydehi, Lecturers, Department of computer Science , dd a comprehensive review for each round.

The event came to an end with the participant feedback session and a photographic session. The participants appreciated the activities conducted as part of this event where they could test their technical skills, and requested for more of such events to be conducted.

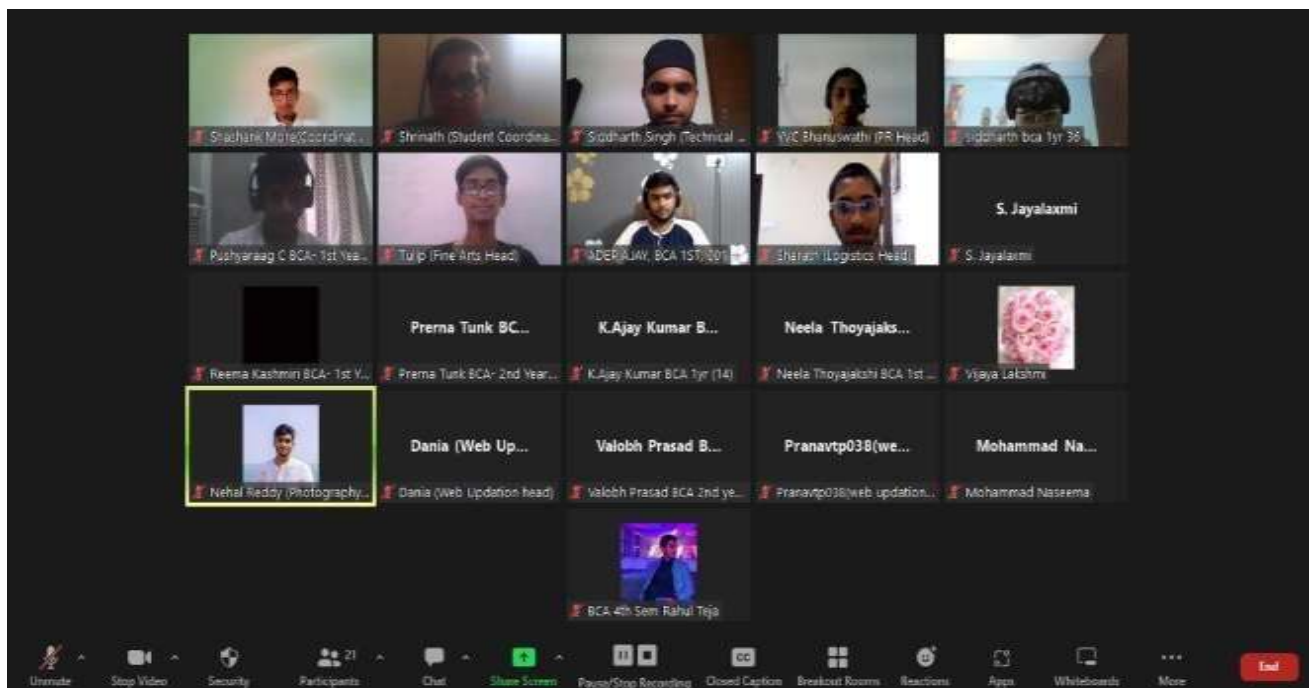

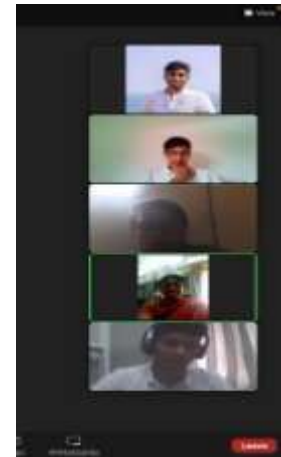
This event began with a registration process for all interested participants. The class groups were given Google forms to fill out. There was a total of 30 student registrations.

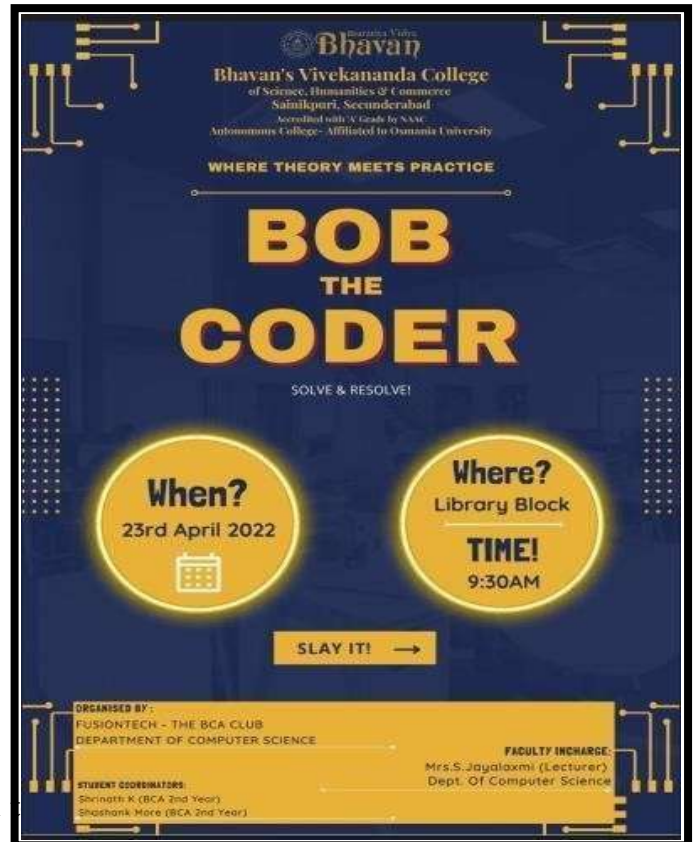
# **BOB THE CODER**

# GAMERS SQUARE



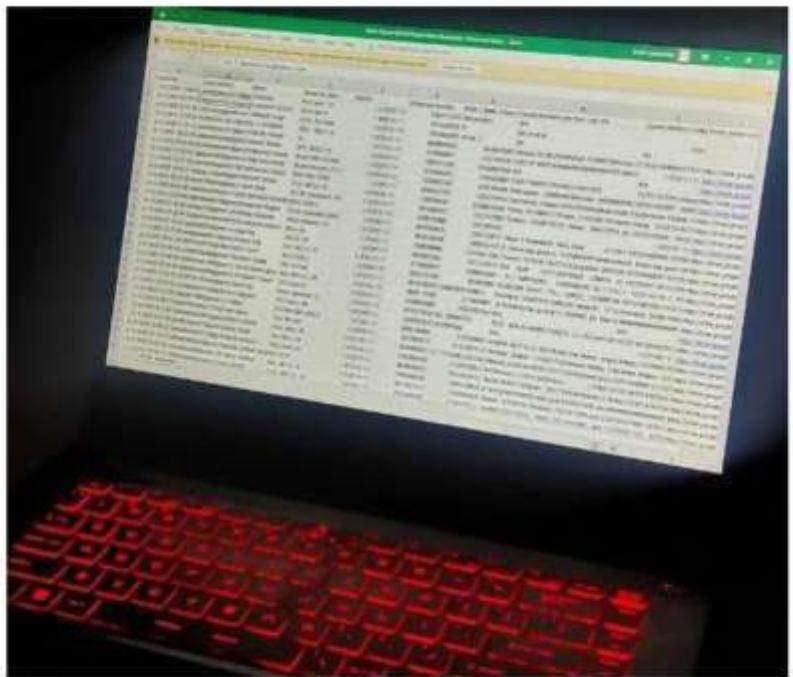

# LOGOVILLE

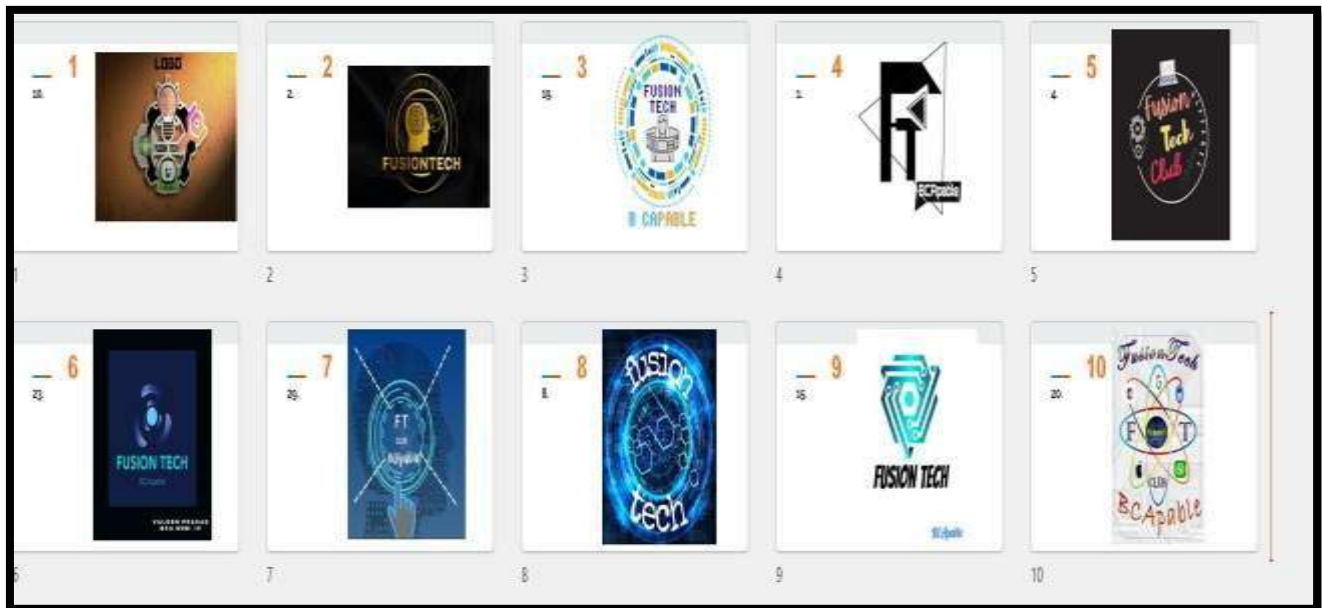
The FusionTech Club under the Department of Computer Science organized an online event called LogoVille which was a Logo Making Competition on 4th April 2022 for all BCA Students.

After evaluating the polls, the Top 10 logos were further sent to the Technical Faculty for further evaluation and top 3 were selected.

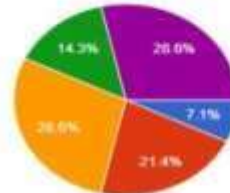

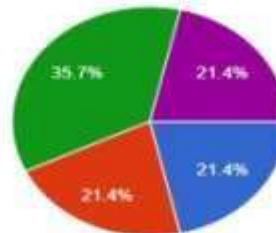

## REPORT ON CONCEPTUAL PANTOMIME

For the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Conceptual Pantomime, the shortlisted groups were given a topic – “Cyber Threats- Causes and their Security Measures”, on which they had to perform a Role play and send the recorded video.

The event helped in students being able to understand and present the subject concepts in a more better and a clear manner.

# TECHNOPHILIA



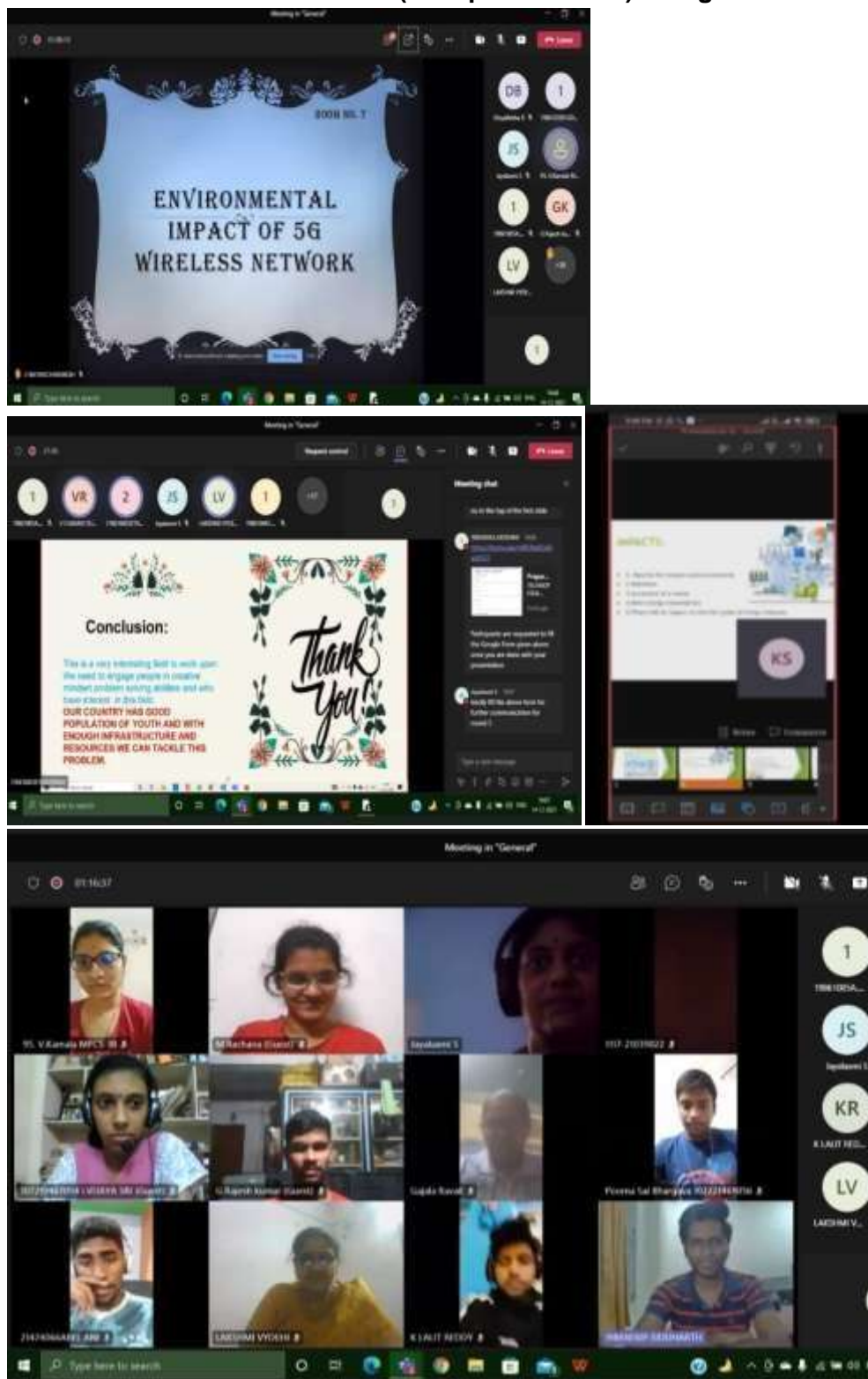

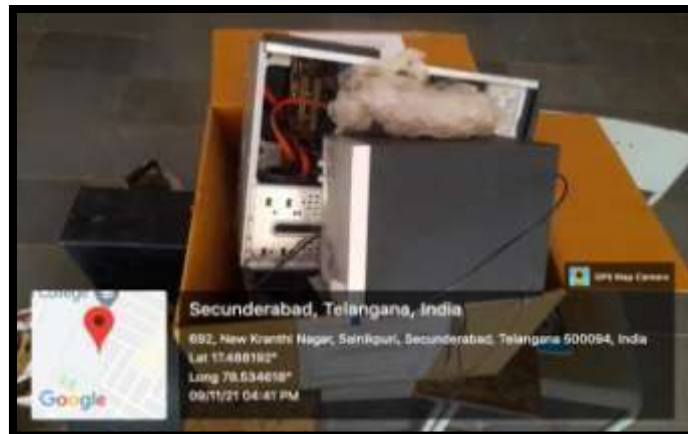
# E-WASTE DRIVE

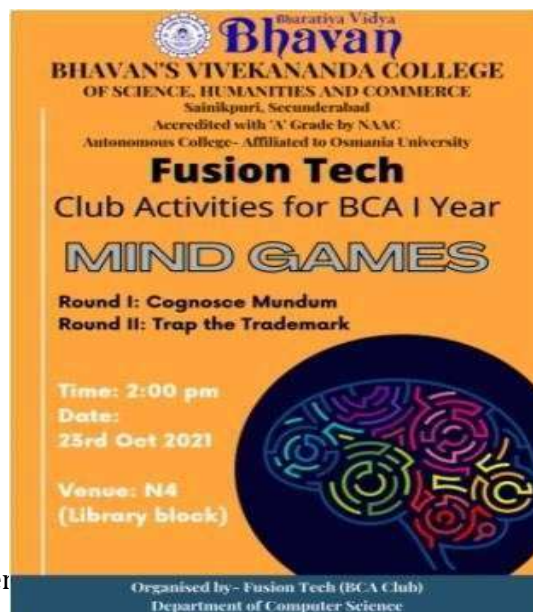
# Mind Games

Event was divided into 3 modules with different activities as :

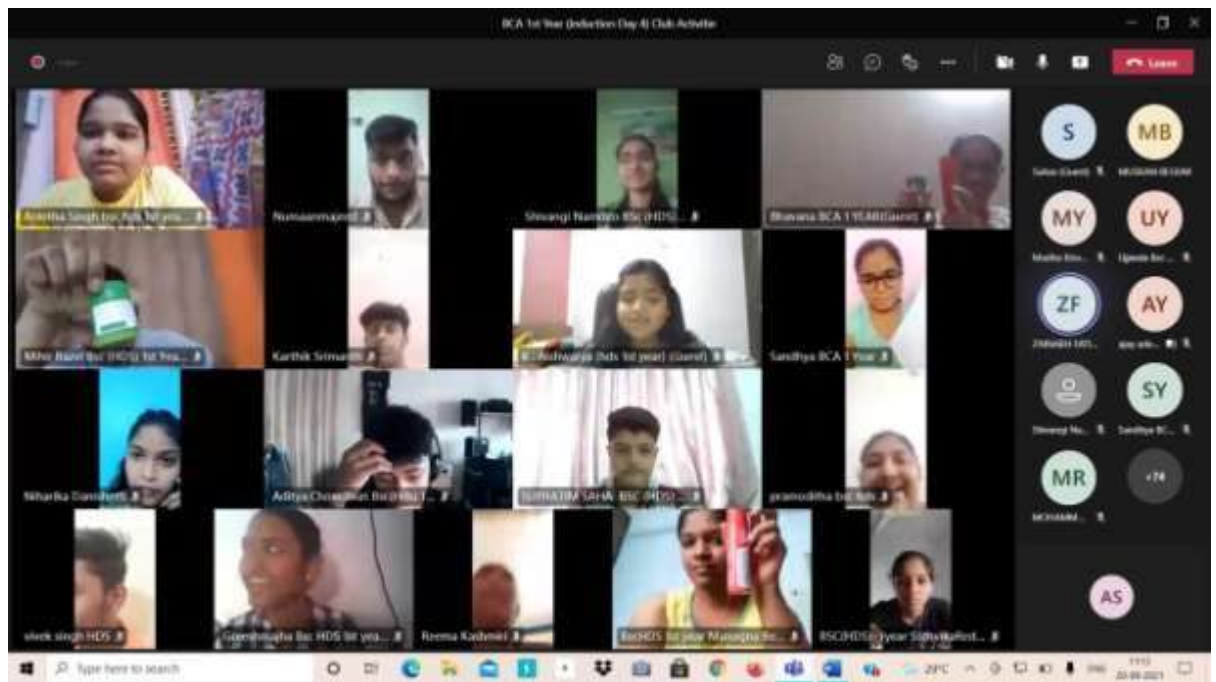
1. Filmy Dunia
