The meeting commenced with a welcome note by the Chairman, Prof. Y.Ashok.

The committee discussed the items of the agenda and resolved them as follows:

**Item 1: Revision of CIA pattern**

A discussion was held regarding the revision of CIA pattern as more parameters were taken into account considering UGC's suggestion regarding comprehensive internal methods:

Existing Pattern of CIA:

- CIA-I: 25 Marks (Objective + Descriptive)
- CIA-II: 25 Marks (Descriptive)
- Assignment: 5 Marks
- Total: 30 Marks (Average of (CIA- I + CIA-II) + Assignment)

Revised Pattern of CIA:

- CIA-I: 15 Marks Online Examination (30 Objective – 30 Mins)
- CIA-II: 30 Marks (1 Hour) – Totally Descriptive
- Attendance: 7 Marks
- Assignment/Quiz/Class room participations/Seminars etc.: 8 Marks
- Total: 30 Marks = Average of (CIA-I (15) + CIA-II (30) + Attendance (7) + Assignments (8)

It was resolved that in the next meeting of the Heads of the Departments, which will be conducted shortly, the method of conducting CIA exam will be discussed and decided.

**Item 2: Proposal for entrance examination in select programmes**

It was proposed to conduct the Entrance Examination for the programmes mentioned below, as there is a minimum demand ratio (1:3):

- BBA
- B. Com (HBA)
- B. Com (Hons)
- B. Com (Computers)

It was suggested to evaluate the reasons for the introduction of entrance exam for the selected courses and to introduce the courses accordingly.

**Item 3: Online feedback system**

It was suggested that students should submit their feedback form online, enter their Roll No. and Aadhar No., following which they would receive their hall tickets. It was suggested that the college needs to take essential preventive measures to safeguard the Aadhar details of the students which are furnished during the process of online feedback.

**Item 4: Outcome Based Education – Assessment**

The measurement and attainment of Outcome Based Education for the batch 2017-20 was presented.

**Item 5: Seminars/Workshops for Quality Improvement**

It was resolved to conduct seminars on NAAC Criteria in the first week of March 2020.

**Any other points**

- It was discussed that online MOOC courses should be made compulsory for UG (HBA & BCA- 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester) and PG ( 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester) students.
- It was communicated to all the members that an amount of 1.23 crores has been disbursed from DBT Star for all the Science groups.
- It was informed that the IQAC team had been working as per the modifications given by the NAAC for the last five years.
- Ms.B S SaiLeena, M.Com II Yr, IV Semester, student representative, suggested that the college should consider the increase in the no. of seats for the General Electives with limited seats.
