Description

The main objective of the NDLI Club is to inculcate a zeal towards the reading the various resources available in library and NDLI among the students of the college. To create awareness among Staff and Students of NDLI Club and NDLI Users Awareness Workshop is being organised.

The total 700 participants registered from NDLI Club portal and 154 students and staff participated in the event and 246 participants present for this event and all are attended the workshop. Dr. Vignesh Sornamohan, Chief Strategic and Outreach Officer, National Digital Library of India, IIT Kharagpur has presented and created awareness among the participants.

Dr. J. Sharada, Club President welcomed all the participants and Mr. L. Vijay Bhasker, Librarian and Secretary of NDLI Club has explained about Digital Library needs, NDLI Club and its different activities which were conducted by NDLI Club on his welcome speech. The Principal and Patron Dr. Y. Ashok addressed the gathering with attempting the Digital Libraries needs, NDLI Club activities and about library resources.

Dr. Vignesh Sornamohan, as a part of the workshop he presented documents available in NDLI website. The NDLI has started its activities initially as a project, now it is expanded beyond the project to increase the content availability. He explained the resources, contents, different formats of the contents, searching filters, how many languages covered, and method of search and retrieves the documents from the NDLI portal and how to narrow down the results and he explained the difference between registered and non registered users and how the registered users can get benefit. He explained the NDLI portal registration process and how to recover their password if anyone forgotten their password. To increase the usage, NDLI has started a new method called NDLI club in all the educational institutions across the country. The activities are formed such that the students are motivated to read any reading material to participate in the activities. In this way students are moved towards the reading activities. This helps the students to increase the capacity to understand not only the technical subjects but also, they can understand more social related subjects. He has concluded his address to increase the student participation in the NDLI Club with monthly activities.




Figure 2: Selected Screen Shots of the event
