Stage 1: Physical Test (Minimum Height: 152 CM for Girls, 160 CM for Boys)

(Running 1.2 km 5 min for boys, 6 min for girls)

Stage 2: Written Test:

Multiple Choice Questions - 50 marks

(GK, Arithmetic, mental aptitude)

Thematic Apperception Test - 10 marks.

Word Association Test - 20 marks.

Quick Response Test - 20 marks.

Stage 3: Personal Interview: short listed cadets in written round are called for personal interview.
