Interim guidance to staff for maintaining COVID-19 protocols during physical conduct of classes from 01.09.21 onwards

1. All the floor and benches in class rooms are sanitized with 5% Dettol on daily basis.
2. All corridors and washrooms are sanitized with 1% Hypochlorite on daily basis.
3. All students should be insisted on wearing mask and temperature checked while entering the campus.
4. Faculty members should continuously monitor wearing mask by the students in the campus. Wearing a mask is mandatory for students and staff in the campus.
5. All students should be insisted on getting hand sanitized at the entrance and in frequent intervals in the campus.
6. Physical distance should be insisted on students in the class rooms and in the campus.
7. Overcrowding of students in the campus at any one particular place (like around canteen area, auditorium etc.,) should be strictly avoided.
8. No entry is permitted for students into the canteen, however food will be served from canteen to outside.
9. Sharing of food and eatables should be discouraged among the student population.



**Information and guidelines to Students for maintaining COVID-19 protocols
in the campus, during Physical conduct of classes from 01.09.2021 onwards**

1. All class rooms, floors and benches are sanitized on a daily basis.
2. All corridors and washrooms are sanitized on daily basis.
3. Thermal scanners and sanitizers are provided at all entry points.
4. All students should wear mask and get temperature checked without fail while entering the campus.
5. Wearing a mask in the campus is mandatory and all students will be continuously monitored by faculty members for wearing mask.
6. All students should take care of sanitizing hands at frequent intervals.
7. Physical distance should be maintained in the class rooms and in the campus.
8. Overcrowding of students in the campus at any one particular place (like canteen area, auditorium etc) is strictly not allowed.
9. No entry is permitted for students into the canteen, however food will be served from canteen to outside.
10. Sharing of food and eatables should be strictly avoided for your own safety.
