The volunteers performed skits, songs, and dances to convey messages in a simple and impactful manner. A speech on the importance of the Indian


Constitution was also delivered, highlighting fundamental rights, duties, and significance of being responsible citizens.

REPORT

Our **NSS volunteers** actively interacted with shopkeepers from different retail and general stores in the locality. They asked questions related to:The extent of plastic usage in daily business. Customer response when plastic covers are not provided. Their willingness to support government bans on plastic usage.Possible alternatives to plastics in their shops.

Volunteer & Shopkeeper Interactions

Volunteer **Vardini** interviewed **Mr. Ashok**, who runs a small retail store.

Questions & Responses:

On daily plastic usage: Mr. Ashok mentioned that he uses a considerable number of plastic covers daily as customers often demand them.

On customer reaction without plastic: He felt customers initially resist but some do bring their own cloth bags.

On plastic ban: He expressed his support for a government ban provided affordable alternatives are available.

Volunteer **Snigdha** interviewed **Mr. Sai Kishore**, owner of a general store.

Questions & Responses:

Daily plastic usage: He highlighted the heavy dependency on plastic for packaging groceries and small items.

Customer behaviour: Many customers expect plastic covers as a basic service, but a few carry reusable bags.

Plastic ban: He welcomed the idea of a ban and said he would cooperate if everyone followed the same rule.

Volunteer **Sindhu** interviewed **Mr. Venu**, who manages a Swagruha chain outlet.

Questions & Responses:

Daily plastic usage: As a food-based store, he admitted using plastics regularly for packaging, though efforts are being made to introduce eco-friendly options.

Customer response: Customers are slowly adapting to paper and cloth packaging.

Plastic ban: He strongly supported the initiative and felt large chains can lead the change by adopting sustainable alternatives.

Volunteer **Deekshitha** interviewed **Mr. Seenu**, another retail store owner.

Questions & Responses:

Daily plastic usage: He acknowledged high usage but was aware of the negative environmental impact.

Customer response: Most customers still prefer plastic for convenience, but awareness is gradually improving.

Plastic ban: He assured that he would support the government's decision if alternatives are provided at reasonable prices.

The survey reflected a positive response from the shopkeepers, who acknowledged both the necessity of plastics in daily business and the importance of moving towards sustainable options. Most of them expressed willingness to support a government ban on plastics if proper alternatives were available.

This survey not only helped spread awareness among the shopkeepers but also gave our NSS volunteers practical insights into public perspectives on environmental issues. It emphasized the importance of collective responsibility, behavioral change, and policy enforcement in reducing plastic usage and protecting the environment.

The activity successfully met its purpose of awareness creation and highlighted the readiness of the community to embrace eco-friendly practices.


