
## Young Leader Programme By Indian School of Business

## 10th June 2022

Career Guidance and Placement cell (CGPC) of the college organized an orientation lecture on Young Leader Programme (YLP) of Indian School of Business (ISB) for the under- graduate students at the college on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at 12 pm. There were 39 students, who attended the orientation lecture. The lecture explained in detail about the YLP wherein ISB gives a unique opportunity to the students to get secured admission to their MBA program before graduation. It is a guaranteed deferred admission program. Before joining the program, a student must have 20 months of real work experience. The session also explained


admission process through YLP. Stage 1 of the process includes good academic score, achievement during the academic years and an essay. The applicant needs to give their GMAT /GRE score, essay, evaluation, and a letter of recommendation in stage 2 followed by interview and results. It was also mentioned that GMAT/GRE score will not be the deciding factor of the admission, all stages of admission are considered for the admission process, and once selected, the applicant required to pay 100,000/- to block the admission.

At the end of the session, the speakers clarified the doubts regarding the admission procedures. The students were even given an option to mail their queries to their website. Interested students could visit







The objective of the training was to assist the students to face campus interviews with confidence. The sessions conducted by the resource person Ms. Sahera Jamal emphasized on the need to have good communication skills, self confidence and etiquettes required in a workplace. Resume writing session assisted the students to prepare their resume in a professional way. The mock interview helped in gaining the confidence to face the real campus interviews.

#### **Report on soft skills classes (M.Sc. Biochemistry)**

Career Guidance and Placement Cell of Bhavan's Vivekananda College of Science, Humanities and Commerce had organized a 26-day value-added course of soft skill classes conducted by Ms. Sahera Jamal for the benefit of PG final year students. The course was from 14/02/2022 to 10/03/2022. The core objective of this course was to improve students' communication which focused on their interpersonal skills. This course addressed different aspects of soft skills, Firstly, the course started off with an introductory session of the students along with their peers which helped in student-to-student communication. #### **Day-1 Report**





Day-1 ended with the above session and students were asked to view the demo video of Create U and then decide upon enrolling for the aptitude course online by downloading the app from play store.




## 5<sup>th</sup> Day Programme on College to Corporate – Designing a Career Path


