
ACTIVITIES 2019-2020

PSCIFE CLUB

The Physical Science Faculty have started a club in the academic year 2010-11 by the name PSCIFE (Physical Science Club for Information, Fun and Education). The main objectives of the club are: To have better inter- departmental interaction for both students and staff. To conduct activities like paper presentation, poster presentation, quiz, fun games, Brain quest, etc. To encourage their analytical skills and to stimulate their thinking and develop confidence. The events conducted for the year 2019-20(June-October) are

WORK WITH YOUR BRAINS

"Work with your brains" is the first event of the academic year 2019-20. This event is a welcome event and an exclusive event only for freshers. The event consists of a bit of in formalism with touch of the subjects. The game consisted of 3 rounds. 28 teams have participated in the event. As a part of first round the participants will be given a 10X10 grid in which they fill terms based on Maths, Computer Science, Physics, Electronics and Statistics respectively. They will be filtered based on their participation for the next round. In the second round they have to solve basic algebraic equations and look for the accurate answer. As a part of the third round which is informal, participants have to separate the water balls from water. The participants who separated the maximum are the winners. The winners of this event are Hiba and Sindhoori.





BRAIN TEASER

This event was conducted 3rd of August on Bhavanostav participating over 40 pairs. This game is all about fun and learning.

It's a small size tambola. This event consists of 2 rounds where in 1st round it all depends on your luck. The hosts have given a paper with a grid and some 40 science words. Words are to be filled in the grid given which consists of 25 boxes with a time limit of 5 minutes.

The rules of the game are:

- 1. No word should be repeated.
- 2. No over writing.

If so paper and participants are disqualified.

After that, hosts pick up the chits in the bowl and participants have to cut each word which matches the picked chit word. Participants whose grid fill are qualified for second round.

Round 2 is about word puzzle and they have given a grid and about 25 words in a pouch and they must arrange the words according to subject wise.

Participants whose grid is correct with all the words subject wise are winners.

A questionnaire was given to everyone who participated with 30 basic general knowledge questions and the more you answer correctly will get you the chance to participate in the actual event.
