MUN Report

Date of the Event: 6/1/2026- 7/12/2026

Venue: 208, MBA Block

The SOCH Club, the Faculty of Arts at Bhavan's Vivekananda College, hosted the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) as part of the Model United Nations (MUN) 2026 conducted on January 6th and 7th. The committee was chaired by Ms. Nandhini Nambiar and Ms. Vedika Gupta, who facilitated a highly engaging and intellectually enriching deliberation. The event provided a platform for students to simulate the proceedings of the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC), engaging in structured debates and diplomatic discussions. The agenda focused on the Human Rights Implications of Artificial Intelligence and Mass Surveillance, allowing delegates to examine issues related to privacy, accountability, and ethical governance in a formal policy-oriented setting.

Throughout the sessions, delegates engaged in negotiations, moderated and unmoderated caucuses, resolution drafting, and consensus-building exercises. The committee encouraged analytical thinking and evidence-based deliberation, enabling participants to evaluate real-world human rights challenges and propose comprehensive policy-oriented solutions aligned with international human rights law.
