Village Surveys and Field Work Details (From 2021-2022)

As part of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) requirements, detailed village-level and household surveys were carried out in all five adopted villages. The surveys enabled meaningful interaction with the rural community, assessment of basic needs, and collection of socio-economic data.

The survey schedule was as follows:

All surveys were conducted using the official Unnat Bharat Abhiyan proforma, and the collected data was compiled and submitted to UBA authorities.

Major Findings / Problems Identified in Villages

During the household and village surveys, the following key issues and developmental gaps were identified:

- Lack of street lights
- Absence of **public toilets**
- Poor awareness of central government schemes
- Poor maintenance of drainage systems
- Inadequate transport facilities
- Lack of awareness about government pension schemes
- Damaged and incomplete road infrastructure in various areas
- Mosquito-related issues due to water stagnation and sanitation gaps
- Limited access to **clean drinking water** in some pockets (if applicable)
- Need for solid waste management measures

These observations highlight the requirement for enhanced infrastructure, sanitation, transportation connectivity, and awareness programs in the adopted villages.
