Bhavya- The Women Cell of Bhavans Vivekananda College celebrated the International Orange Day to eliminate the Violence against Women and bring awareness about the same.

International orange is celebrated from 25th November 2022 to 10th December 2022.

Bhavya the women cell celebrated the first day of International Orange Day in Bhavans Sri Ramakrishna Vidyalaya.

The programme commenced with the speech by Shika, Deekshita, and Suhana. A song on Women was sung by Sirisha and the group. NCC Cadets performed a skit to stop the Violence against Women. The event was followed by the sale of Orange Ribbons. A total of 263 boys and 370 girls have participated in the orange day by buying the Orange Ribbons. 9 boys and 10 girls have volunteered for the programme on Day 1.

Day 2 the programme was celebrated in Bhavans Vivekananda College. The event was declared open by releasing the Orange Balloons by Principal sir G.S.V.R.K Choudhary, HODs of Departments, Bhavya Cell Coordinator Mrs. PV Ajitha mam and the member of Bhavya Cell. Song was sung by Aishwarya when the balloons were released. A total of 6 boys and 15 girls took the initiative of volunteering. 52 boys and 76 girls have participated in the event by donating money in the form of buying Orange Ribbons.

Day 3 the programme was celebrated in Bhavans Sri Aurobindo Junior College. The event started with the introduction to orange day by Jyotsna. Speech by Shika, Deepshikha and Suhana followed by a group song sung by students. A skit was performed by NCC Cadets on Violence against Women. Followed by sale of Ribbons. 493 boys and 466 girls have participated in the event. 5 boys and 11 girls have volunteered for the event.

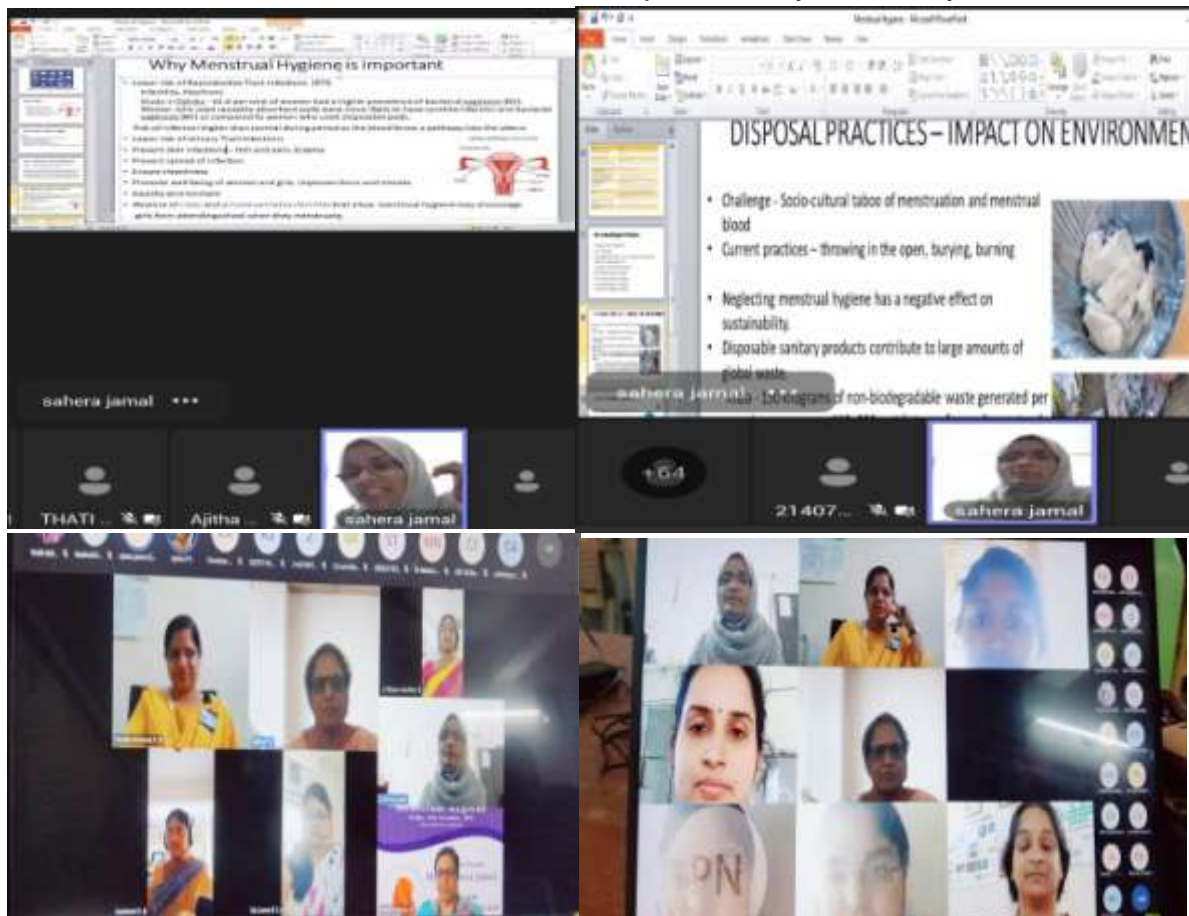

REPORT ON MENSTRUAL HYGIENE

For billions of young people worldwide, menstruation is a monthly reality. Yet in many countries, they still face serious challenges when it comes to managing their periods. Myths, stigma and harmful gender norms around menstruation exacerbate the difficulties for young people across the world. Keeping this in view **Bavya- The Women cell** of Bhavans Vivekananda college of Science, Humanities and Commerce was conducted an online awareness session for UG and PG girls on **“MENSTRUAL HYGIENE”** on **11th November, 2022** in association with NCC, NSS and BSG by the resource person **Mrs Sahera Jamal**. A large number of adolescent girls are still not aware about issues related to menstruation and maintaining personal hygiene during this period and dealing with associated physical problems. They usually don't get a proper platform to get information or discuss such issues. The resource person Mrs Sahera Jamal focussed on topics related to menstruation were explained to girls, like what is menstruation, physical problems faced by girls during their periods and ways to deal with it, maintaining personal hygiene during this period and importance of maintaining hygiene, promoting use of sanitary napkins, menstrual cups etc. Traditional myths and misconceptions related to menstruation were discussed. Total 90 participants took part in the session with enthusiasm and interacted with the resource person very effectively.
